WHEAT CROP WILL NOT COME UP TO EXPECTATIONS OF THE EARLY SEASON.

The East Oregonian has caused quite careful inquiry to be made throughout the county to ascertain what will be approximately the yield of wheat from the 1900 crop.

A week before threshing began predictions were common for a bumper yield. Estimates ranged from 3,000,000 to 6,000,000 bushels for the county.

At this time, according to the figures gathered, the total tonnage of wheat will not be more than 4,400,000 to 4,800,000 bushels.

Northwest winds, from Pendleton in localities in which ordinarily smaller yields are had, the crops are exceeding expectations.

Quality Holds No. 1. Previous assertions regarding the quality are borne out by the returns from the harvesters.

the following from the La Grande Journal: "About three months ago the San Francisco Examiner contained the news of a damaged vessel in the harbor containing coffee and sheep dip. The two articles of commerce were found floating in the hold, and the merchants to whom they were consigned refused to accept them, not only because they were water soaked, but because the sheep dip had not had a salutary effect upon the coffee. One of our home merchants at that time presented that Eastern Oregon would soon be overrun with cheap coffee. There is now in this section a man who offers to sell for eight cents a grade of coffee which our merchants cannot buy wholesale for twelve. There may be some connection between the two incidents."
