### FALSE FIRE ALARM.

It is the duty of the City Jail Has His Little Joke.

Almost every time there is a fire alarm the reporter has an opportunity of stating that "the hoarse cry of fire startled the residents," etc., but last night it was different. Hundreds of people were gathered at the corner of Court and Cottonwood streets watching the pictures as they were shown on the screen by the vitascope man. There was an alarm, but it wasn't hoarse; neither did it startle anyone to any great extent. Instead of being hoarse, it was soprano in tone, and sepulchral, as though rising from the bottom of a well or interment recesses of a cavern. A few prominent firemen segregated themselves from the crowd and jogged toward the central fire bell, near the city jail, on Cottonwood street. The cry of fire was heard spasmodically for a few seconds and ended in a wail. The sound was traced to a place of emanation and found to proceed from the occupant of the jail, who had become tired of monotony and took that means of arousing excitement.

The bell was not tolled. The crowd continued to gaze upon the pictures. The solid doors of the jail were closed over the hoarse ones, and quietness reigned over the scene.

Some of the firemen were disposed to gag the man who had yelled fire, but wiser counsel prevailed.

### EXCURSION FROM PORTLAND.

#### CHAMBER OF COMMERCE WILL COME AS ANNOUNCED.

President Taylor Takes up the Matter Officially and Addresses His Members.

The Portland Oregonian of Sunday issue contains this reference to the proposed excursion of wholesalers and manufacturers for the Pendleton Street Fair and Harvest Carnival:

"Portland is to return Pendleton and East Oregon's friendly visit to the street fair. President Taylor, of the Chamber of Commerce, announces that there will be a Chamber of Commerce day at Pendleton either September 21 or 22, when the Portland Chamber and Portland merchants are expected to attend. That they will do so in large numbers is evident from preparations now under way. Of course, all Portland cannot well go, but a large number of her commercial and business men generally can and will. A. H. Devers has been faithfully working for several days to secure the names of all that can join the excursion. A hearty sentiment seems to be growing that this is the opportunity for the big metropolis to pay a visit to her neighbor of the inland Empire.

"In a circular issued by the Chamber of Commerce, President Taylor urges all to attend, and tersely lays down reasons why business men should feel it a duty. He says:

"The people of Pendleton are making great efforts to carry their harvest carnival to success, and have written to the Portland Chamber of Commerce expressing the hope that a large portion of the wholesale dealers, manufacturers and merchants generally will attend.

#### Strive for Good Feeling.

"The Chamber of Commerce has earnestly been striving for the past two years to foster a good feeling between Portland and the cities of the interior, and feels that the effort has been attended with considerable success. Therefore, the chamber feels now that it is not out of place to urge all business men and manufacturers to do so to join the excursion to Pendleton for the last or the next to the last day of that city's fair, which would be September 21 or 22. Arrangements have been made for an excursion train to leave Portland either the evening of Thursday, September 19, or Friday, the day following. The Chamber of Commerce earnestly hopes that Portland will give this matter considerable attention.

"J. E. Lathrop, secretary and superintendent of the Pendleton carnival, in his letter to the Portland Chamber of Commerce, says: "The Pendleton Street Fair and Harvest Carnival Association and the Commercial Association of Pendleton, through me, urge upon you and your Chamber of Commerce to assist in making up an excursion of business men and manufacturers from Portland to Pendleton during one day of our street fair and harvest carnival. We have received substantial encouragement from all with whom we have communicated, have the hearty support of the Oregonian and the Evening Telegram, and also the O. R. & N. Principle of Commonwealth Patriotism.

"We shall present as an argument why members of your chamber should take hold of the matter the necessity of demonstrating occasionally the existence of a spirit of co-operation and sympathy, which is the good of the commonwealth and patriotism. We know that Portland's strength is our strength, and in a much lesser degree and yet to an extent our strength is Portland's strength. Let me suggest to you that the first voluntary appropriation for opportunity to represent interests at our fair and harvest carnival came from Seattle. With all due respect to Seattle, and other cities, our interests are bound up in Portland, and it is in no spirit of holiday jaunting and schoolboy excursion that we suggest this arrangement. The development of Oregon's resources and the acquaintance of the business men of our metropolis with those centers where they trade urge for this excursion.

"If you will permit me to add, we will instruct you regarding the growth of a society of a large number of men in the past few years which you are accustomed to regard as a village.

"Superintendent Lathrop, in a later letter, speaks of the advantage of closer acquaintance, especially where such sharp competition from Chicago, Omaha and St. Louis is growing. In reply to this, President Taylor said he fully recognized that the city needs adjacent territory and that adjacent territory needs a city, and promised active efforts to make the excursion a grand success, which he and Mr. Devers have faithfully kept.

"So far as heard, the sentiment among Portland merchants and manufacturers is that the excursion must be a large one. President Taylor has wired Superintendent Lathrop that he would be there. Promises have been secured from a number of other business men, and the campaign is still in progress. If business men would indicate to Mr. Devers or President Taylor what they intend to do much trouble and time would be saved them and those aiding in arranging the details of the excursion.

#### RUSSIAN THISTLE SCARE.

Farmers From McKay Precinct Call Upon the County Court.

A Russian thistle scare is attracting as much attention among the farmers of McKay precinct as the wheat crop or the Pendleton Street Fair and Harvest Carnival. They are alarmed. The thistle has obtained a hold upon numerous farms and along several of the roads leading through the country to the south of Pendleton. Last Saturday afternoon a delegation of McKay farmers called upon the county court and stated the cause of their fears and talked over means to be employed to stamp out the menace to their success in raising crops. George Jones, E. N. Smith, Dan Shaw, Dell Davis, Anton Larson, G. O. Miller, Fred Kamrath, Dave Shoemaker, and John McKeown composed the party. Some of them stated that their lands were overgrown with the thistle, and that the lands of others were likewise covered. Dell Davis said he had already ploughed up 100 acres of land covered with thistles, and would have to treat 60 more acres in a similar manner in order to get rid of them. Another of the farmers present said he had 90 acres, of which 40 acres had thistles, and had them all ploughed, and he would plough them under. It was represented that the land of Frank and

James Roach was growing thistles and that thistles were growing along the road from McKay creek to the reservation, several miles south of Pendleton. These lands were formerly a part of the Umatilla reservation, but are now deeded lands, having been sold under direction of the government several years ago.

#### Drive to McKay Precinct.

Commissioners Gilliland and Walker, and Tom Thompson took a drive Sunday to the fields in McKay precinct designated by the above mentioned farmers as having thistles growing upon them, and found that the situation had been correctly presented. Little thistles were springing up only a few inches high, around near the old ones, indicating that seed of this year's blossoms had already been scattered by the winds and had taken root.

The matter was thoroughly discussed by the county court today. It transpires that Russian thistles are also growing in Fulton, Echo and Milton precincts. The road supervisors will be instructed to see that the law is enforced in regard to their extermination, and to keep the road through their respective precincts clear of the dangerous weed.

Any person permitting the Russian thistle to grow upon his premises and go to seed is guilty of a misdemeanor and is subject to a fine of \$10 for the first offense and \$25 for each subsequent offense. A road supervisor permitting a Russian thistle to grow along a road over which he has supervision is subject to a fine of \$50.

The federal authorities will be asked to make an appropriation and assist in keeping the thistle off the Umatilla Indian reservation.

When an owner of land refuses or neglects to dig out thistles growing there the work may be done by the road supervisor and the cost thereof charged as a lien against the property.

#### FIRST SHOOT OF THE SEASON

A Large Number of Sportsmen Test the New Mautratap.

A large number of sportsmen were present Sunday on the grounds of the Pendleton Sportsmen Association to test the new mautratap, and a good day's sport was enjoyed. The trap works to perfection and only broke two per cent of bluebirds handled, which is a great record. The shooting was done by squads of six and 975 bluebirds were shot at in less than three and one-half hours. With the old expert traps the shooting of such a large number of targets would have consumed a day. The matches were shot off rapidly, making it pleasant alike for shooters and spectators.
