TOM JOHNSON A WINNER.

Thomas L. Johnson has been elected mayor of Cleveland, Ohio. Watch the future of Tom Johnson. He is a coming man. He is a man who wins his fights. He is a man who fights for noble ends. His policies make for better conditions for the workingmen, not because he attempts works of charity for them, but because he seeks only justice for himself and justice for them. He is a rich man, yet is adorned as a political leader by the masses. Cleveland is the home of Mark Hanna, United States senator and chairman of the republican national committee. Akers made the fight backed by all the republican strength of the city, state and the influence of the administration secured through Senator Hanna. Perhaps Tom Johnson will be a presidential candidate before the democratic convention. That convention would pursue a long and wearying search before finding a better man to offer to the people as a chief executive.

APPOINTING A TRUST ATTORNEY.

It is almost unthinkable that President McKinley will appoint Philander C. Knox to the federal attorney-generalship. He represents the following corporations: Carnegie Steel company, the Vanderbilt system, Pittsburgh & Birmingham Traction company, Pittsburgh, Fort Wayne & Chicago railroad company, the Baden Gas company, and was argued before President McKinley by J. Pierpont Morgan for the portfolio.

This is not to say that Mr. Knox is not able enough to perform the duties required. He is abundantly equipped mentally and in experience. But, when the impression has become so generally prevalent throughout the country that the administration is controlled in the interest of the trusts and combinations, it would appear to be a wise move on his part to appoint to the attorney-generalship some lawyer who is free from any business attachments such as bind Mr. Knox to the corporations that have had him on their list as their counsel.

There are many men in the law who are fully as eminent, men who would bring to the cabinet as much of erudition and professional experience as will be contributed by Mr. Knox, and were another selected, Mr. McKinley would avoid the act of self-conviction of the charges brought against him by his political enemies.

It is doubtless true that Mr. Knox could to a large extent overcome a bias in favor of the corporations that have paid him retainers sufficiently large to have enabled him to accumulate a million-dollar fortune, for he is himself wealthy. But human nature has too many weaknesses, and it is rather too much to ask that people look complacently upon the appointment to a cabinet position of one who, when anti-trust legislation and other anti-trust issues come up at any time, will naturally incline to support those who have made him rich.

The \$20,000,000 expended in purchasing the Philippine archipelago has represented only one-tenth of the cost that has accrued. A summary of the expense in money and life shows as follows: Army officers killed or died from wounds, 54; privates killed or died from wounds, 830; navy officers killed or died from wounds, 2; enlisted men killed or died from wounds, 16; deaths from disease, officers, 48;

states, New York, New Jersey, Delaware and Pennsylvania, Ohio, Indiana, Michigan and other Western states, one being on the Pacific coast. Most of them are in Pennsylvania Michigan and Illinois.

As the very names of the combinations suggest, some of the constituent companies were enormously large—five years ago—the big Carnegie plant, for instance, which only appears as one of twelve in the above table; others were of course small—some of the little tin-plate companies, for example. To get a point of view let us assume a sort of average company—a corporation employing, say, 500 men and doing business with a capital of say, \$5,000,000.

The steel colossus would contain of such companies no less than three hundred and twenty. As a matter of fact it contains nearly twice that number of separate industrial organizations, few of which were not in existence some form five years ago. There is not a city and there are few towns between the Atlantic and the Mississippi in the Northern states where iron manufactures of any kind are carried on that have not one or more arms belonging to the steel colossus.—New York World.
