COURT CONVENES MONDAY

CASES SET FOR TRIAL DURING FIRST EIGHT DAYS.

Judge Eakin will sit for the first three days for Judge Ellis. Circuit Judge Ellis returned from Portland Friday morning and has spent most of the day in the preparation of the docket for the next term of court, which convenes on Monday, October 14. Most of the law firms that have cases coming up for trial this term were represented at the court house in the afternoon, to make known to the court whether or not their cases were ready for trial. Nine cases were chosen from the law docket and set for trial during the first eight days of court. There is an unusually large number of cases this term both in law and equity. The greater part of the criminal business since the last regular session has been completed and what remains will be quickly disposed of. Judge Ellis will return to Portland on account of the illness of his son and Judge Eakin of Union will preside in his place on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday of next week.
