# THE LOST IS FOUND

CHARLES RICH WANTED  
BY PHILADELPHIA FAMILY.

Found in Jail at Walla Walla—He is Charged With Shooting and Killing a Calf.

Walla Walla, Jan. 4.—Through the medium of newspaper advertising, a man has been found in Walla Walla jail, and when the authorities are through with him he will be returned to his family and friends. Until that time he will remain a guest of Walla Walla county.

Charles Rich left a family and a home in Philadelphia a year ago, and came to Washington. For a time he reported progress regularly, then all trace was lost and he was thought to be dead. In addition the family received a letter signed by John Andrews, stating that Rich had been killed in an explosion of a threshing machine near this city last September. Upon this information his family set out to locate the body and get some facts relative to the accident. They took the newspapers, and asked

tended to serve 60 days in jail. All this time he gave the name of John or "Jack" Andrews, the name he had chosen for the man who advised his family of the threshing machine accident.

Shortly after Rich went to jail the children of Mrs. Ostrander were reported starving and they were brought to the city for care. They are now in the county jail, awaiting a hearing looking to their becoming wards of the home-finding society. Mrs. Ostrander has been a true friend of Rich through all the trouble, and was surprised to learn the facts in the case.

Rich is a striking character, and the description sent out by his family was so perfect that he was easily located among the 17 prisoners in the jail. He is of very light complexion, stands six feet, thin, bony and strong, wears false teeth, appears to be about 22 years of age, although he is 26 years old. He is a member of the Woodmen.

Rich, or Jack Andrews, as he is known at the jail, was one of the ring-leaders in the attempt to break jail three weeks ago, and after his sentence expires he will be tried on the charge of jail breaking, and very likely get another term in jail. Meanwhile his friends have been notified of the presence of Rich in this city.

for assistance in locating the missing man. One of the notices came to this city, and within a few hours afterwards the man was located in the county jail, where he is serving a sentence of 60 days for killing a calf.

Reveries met Rich last fall, and he became discouraged and broke. Disliking to let his family know of his plight, he had a friend write the letter telling of his tragic death in the explosion, and supposed his family would consider him dead and make no search. He had met rough companions, learned to gamble and was fast becoming a bad man, when he came to this city.

Among his friends was Mrs. Ostrander, living near Dixie in the mountains. She was in straitened circumstances, and Rich pitied her. He had no money, and concluded to get food some way. So he took a gun and set out. Soon he came upon a fat calf and shot it. Just then the owner appeared and Rich was in serious trouble. He was taken to jail, and later tried, convicted and sentenced to serve 60 days in jail.
