WHERE HAVE THESE MISSING CATTLE GONE?

McKay Creek Stockman Says Loss Is Ten Per Cent. for Many Owners.
A. M. Isaacs, the cattle man who was in town Monday from his place on upper McKay creek, says that out of between 1200 and 1500 head of cattle owned and ranged in his neighborhood last summer, 150 are missing. This makes the missing almost 10 per cent, which is more than three times what it ought to be, as Mr. Isaacs says that 3 per cent. is a large loss, and that he does not lose on an average more than 2 per cent. during the whole season.
The range for many miles around where these cattle run has been ridden over time and time again by those who are short in the fall roundup, and none of the missing have been found. Mr. Isaacs is out nine head out of 300, which he says is the smallest loss of any of his neighbors. He hesitates to say they have been stolen, but admits that it looks very much that way, as he cannot account for the loss unless they have been "rustled" and run out of the country.

LOW MILL FEED RATE.
O. R. & N. Reduces Tariff From \$1 Per 100 Car Lots to 60 Cents.
General Agent H. M. Adams, of the O. R. & N., is in receipt of a telegram from the general freight department announcing a reduction of the rate on mill feed in carload lots from The Dalles and all points east thereof, including Spokane, to Colorado common points. The present rate on mill feed from Spokane to Denver, Colorado Springs or Pueblo is \$1 per 100 pounds, carload lots. Under the new tariff the rate will be 60 cents per 100 pounds in cars of a minimum capacity of 30,000 pounds, or a reduction of 40 cents per 100 pounds. The new rate will be effective Tuesday, January 7.
