no rights or power to exercise the powers as mayor or councilmen. That the defendants, against the protest of the plaintiff, on the 11th of January, 1902, did deceitfully, fraudulently and wrongfully conspire together to cloud the title of the defendants to hold said offices and perform the duties thereto connected and pretended to appoint William Lane and L. G. Frazier as marshal and recorder, and in furtherance of said conspiracy, that T. G. Halley administered the oath of office to Lane and declared him the marshal, and thereafter said William Lane fraudulently and in furtherance of the conspiracy, claimed to be the marshal of Pendleton, and unless constrained by an order of the court, will continue to claim to be marshal and to harass and annoy plaintiff Heathman in his duties.

**WALLA WALLA'S EVANGEL FOR GOOD PUBLIC ROADS.**

County Supervisors Will Confer—Talk of Crushed Rock in Washington. Walla Walla, Jan. 13.—The question of good roads has taken a new hold upon the people of Walla Walla county, and concerted action looking to a permanent betterment of public highways is about to be made. The county commissioners have called a meeting of all the road supervisors of the county at the court house February 4, to consider the question of permanent improvement. The meeting has been made a part of the business of supervisors by the board making an allowance of \$2.50 for each member roadmaker present. It is expected that every supervisor will be present. The plan is to have a number of practical papers upon road improvements, and one or two addresses will be made by practical road builders. All the various matters pertaining to roads and bridges will be considered.

**Straw Day's Good Effect.** Last summer an innovation in the way of Straw Day was introduced, when farmers turned out and littered straw over the roads to prevent the disagreeable dust which rises in hot weather in the light soil section of the country. The experiment proved successful, in a way, and tended to show what could be done in a concerted movement for better public highways. In some places the roads are much better this winter than ever known, on account of the amount of straw which became mixed with the soil from the experiment of "straw day."

Another Straw Day Coming. One plan likely to be adopted by the supervisors is a general straw day in the spring, when an effort will be made to interest everyone in the matter. An old fashioned "bee" is being considered, when a sumptuous lunch will be served and farmers will be asked to turn out in a body and haul straw over as much roadway as possible. In this way, it is said, much of the highways leading to this city can be placed in good condition for the summer's travel.

In Columbia county a plan is now on foot to place crushed rock on several miles of roadway this summer. A rock crusher has been purchased jointly by the city of Dayton and Columbia county, and the machine will be used during the coming months to test the rock process of making permanent roads. So far in this county no effort has been made to experiment with crushed rock on country roads, although the streets of this city are made solely of the product of a rock crusher and earth. The street grading has proved satisfactory, and the work has been done with no great expense.

**Mrs. Van Orsdall Returned.** Mrs. Carrie C. Van Orsdall, grand guardian Women of Woodcraft, returned yesterday evening from Portland, where she paid an official visit to the seven circles in that city. She says Woodcraft is booming in the metropolis of Oregon, and she had a very pleasant as well as profitable time. They are preparing for a big time on the 3d of February, when Head Consul Falkenburg is to pay them a visit.
