OUR CRATER LAKE

EFFORT TO MAKE IT A NATIONAL PARK.

Will G. Steele, Well-Known Mazama, Heads the Movement—Congressman Tongue Assists.

Will G. Steele, of Portland, has inaugurated the movement on behalf of the Society of the Mazamas, for securing action by congress to make Crater Lake a national park. He has taken hold of the matter with vigor, and will enlist the co-operation of all persons who are interested in such things. Mr. Steele calls upon the people of the state to exert themselves in every manner possible, and he will no doubt have the support of all who desire that the wonderful lake be preserved as a place to which during all time people will go upon their pleasure jaunts.

The following petition sets forth the facts and should have the signatures of all Oregonians:

To the Senate and House of Representatives in Congress Assembled:

Your petitioners, residents of the state of Oregon, respectfully set forth the following facts, and ask your consideration thereof:
Crater Lake is located on the summit of the Cascade range of mountains, in Klamath county, Oregon, and is one of the grandest natural wonders of the world. It is a portion of the unappropriated vacant domain of the government, and in the opinion of your petitioners should be set apart and maintained as a national park. To this end Hon. Thomas H. Tongue has introduced in your honorable body H. R. 4393, for which we respectfully request your support.

The surface of the lake is 6239 feet above sea level, it is nearly six miles in diameter and is completely surrounded by nearly perpendicular walls from 1000 to 2000 feet high. It contains a circular island, or cinder cone, 845 feet high, in the top of which is an extinct crater 90 feet deep. The water is clear as crystal, 2000 feet deep and of the richest possible blue. Adjoining the lake and guarding its approaches the mountains are rugged, of great altitude and of no value for agriculture or mining. In spite of laws to the contrary, wild game in the Pacific Northwest is rapidly disappearing, and unless steps are taken in the near future to provide a refuge for it, many varieties will become extinct.

Therefore, your petitioners ask your favorable consideration of H. R. 4393.
