### GENERAL NEWS

The United States transport Sheridan has arrived in Manila from San Francisco with many sick on board, including 30 cases of measles.

Emperor William signalized his 43d birthday by conferring territorial titles on all the regiments which hitherto have borne no distinctions nor names.

At Columbus, O., Herbert D. Bennett, president of the American District Telegraph Company, died suddenly at his home of heart disease, aged 34.

The most severe weather conditions exist in the Lake Superior region, where the temperature ranged from 5 below to 12 below and the wind blew a gale.

Dr. Harry J. Zeigler, of 116 West King street, Lancaster, Pa., fatally wounded his wife, Anna, and then killed himself in Chicago. A certificate by the physician stated that he and his wife had decided to die, and as he lacked the nerve, Mrs. Zeigler had promised to commit the act.

The 15 men of the command of Captain David D. Porter, of the United States marine corps, who failed to return from the expedition into the interior of Burma when Capt. Porter and 25 members of his party reached the coast of that island, January 21, are still missing, and little news of their safe return is entertained.

Another great step in the utilization of Niagara power is announced by the Electrical World and Engineer. Contracts have just been placed with the General Electric Company for the construction of three 11,000 horse-power generators for the new plant, whose ultimate capacity, it is estimated, will probably reach 200,000 horse-power.

### PACIFIC NORTHWEST NEWS

An attempt is being made to make capital out of the delay in reporting the canal bill, but Senator Mitchell says the time will be saved in having every possible feature of opposition to Nicaragua development in the committee.

At Elberton, Wash., the honeymoon of Mr. and Mrs. Dillin, of California, was rudely broken into by a smallpox scare, and instead of completing their wedding trip to Lewiston, Idaho, they have been spending their time at the county pest house.

Representative Tongue presented to the president a petition from citizens of Lake county, endorsed by the governor, state treasurer and secretary of state of Oregon, protesting against the dismissal of the present forestry officials of their state.

The nimble Kerrigan, at the Multnomah Club, in Portland, cleared the bar at 6 feet 3/4 inches, breaking the American record, which was 5 feet 11 inches. Kerrigan did the trick without difficulty, and received generous applause from the 300 club members who were present.

The president, after making private inquiries as to the character and ability of William Farre, of Canyon City, sent in his nomination as register of the Burns land office, in accordance with the recommendation of Representative Moody. The nomination of Bilbee for Oregon City is still held up, apparently at the request of Senator Simon.

That ex-State Treasurer Thil Metzeban deposited state funds in the Williams & Ensland Bank and received interest thereon was when Barker A. Bush tried to prove in the circuit court at Salem. Evidence tending strongly to support that view of the case was introduced, but whether it proves the fact is yet to be decided by the court.

Willis Dodge, a special messenger, arrived in Baker City, bringing with him a bottle of the first oil struck in the celebrated Malheur basin. The oil came from the Newell well, now being sunk by the Newell Oil Company, of Nampa, a short distance from the town of Nampa. It was obtained at a depth of 110 feet. The oil analyzes 75 per cent paraffine.

### A PORTLAND PAPER ON FURNISH'S CHANCES

Telegram Quotes Eastern Oregon Man as to Probabilities of the Convention.

People hereabouts read with interest the statements made by the outside newspapers relative to the prospects of the candidates for the republican nomination for the governorship. In the Portland Telegram of Monday, January 27, appears a statement of an eastern Oregon man.

"What is more," he continued, "Mr. Furnish will have a solid delegation from Umatilla county, a majority of the delegates from Baker county and perhaps all of Union county's delegation. There is not a stronger man in eastern Oregon, and he is not obliged to make combinations to secure support. Instead of seeking alliances with other candidates the latter are seeking alliances with him.

The charge that Mr. Furnish is too new a man in the republican party to seek the highest office within the gift of the people of Oregon, is met by the reminder that Mr. Furnish, along with many other gold democrats, came to the relief of the republican party when it was most in need of votes. Had it not been for this timely assistance the state would undoubtedly have been captured by Bryanism and populism. But Mr. Furnish is not even responsible for his candidacy. He was pushed to the front by many influential republicans, who recognized in him the strongest man in eastern Oregon at this time. Eastern Oregon demands recognition on the state ticket, and Mr. Furnish has been selected as the most likely man to receive the recognition.

### ANOTHER CASE OF INDIAN WITCHCRAFT

Similar to that of the killing of Ann Edna on the Umatilla Reservation.

In the Matinkella, where is located the mission of the well known Rev. Mr. Duncan, a case of killing by magic or the supposed exercise of witchcraft has occurred, which is similar in some respects to that of the killing of Ann Edna on the Umatilla reservation. It is but one of the numerous cases of like nature that has been recorded during the past few months. It appears to be almost the universal belief among the Indians that witches should die, and it is not difficult to find the proper Indian to do the killing when once the tribesmen have become convinced that a witch has used his powers to hurt their people.

The steamer Teos has arrived from the north with news of the arrest of two Indians charged with the recent murder of a Japanese in connection with the tribal war at Matinkella between the Indians of rival villages. From the statement of the prisoners, it appears that they had blamed the Japanese or a man living with him for practicing sorcery, to which they ascribed the death of several of their tribe. By way of revenge they killed Kamamura, the Japanese, in the belief that it would save the rest of the tribe from the consequences of Kamamura's witchcraft.

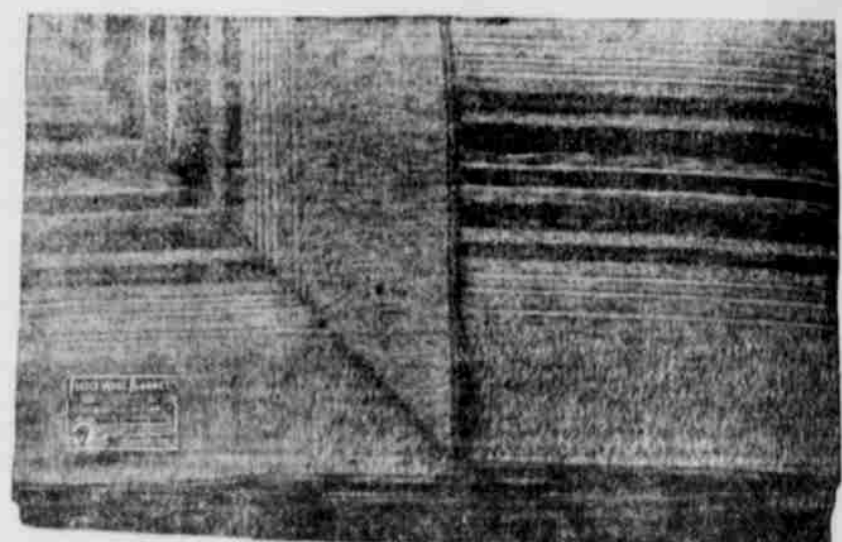
