Portland, Jan. 30.—The Commercial Review says:
Local trade has been spiritless, not from any lack of demand, but entirely due to meager offerings for holders. In spite of weak and declining markets in Europe and America, seem to place little importance to the course of other markets and appear determined to force buyers to either meet their ideas as a values or to hold on to their grain. The result is that they are compelled to keep their wheat, as exporters refuse to operate at anything above a parity with values in Europe. Choice wheat, suitable for milling purposes is held at such stiff prices that millers cannot afford to do much buying, and if this keeps up many of the large plants will soon shut down, as milling is now unprofitable.
