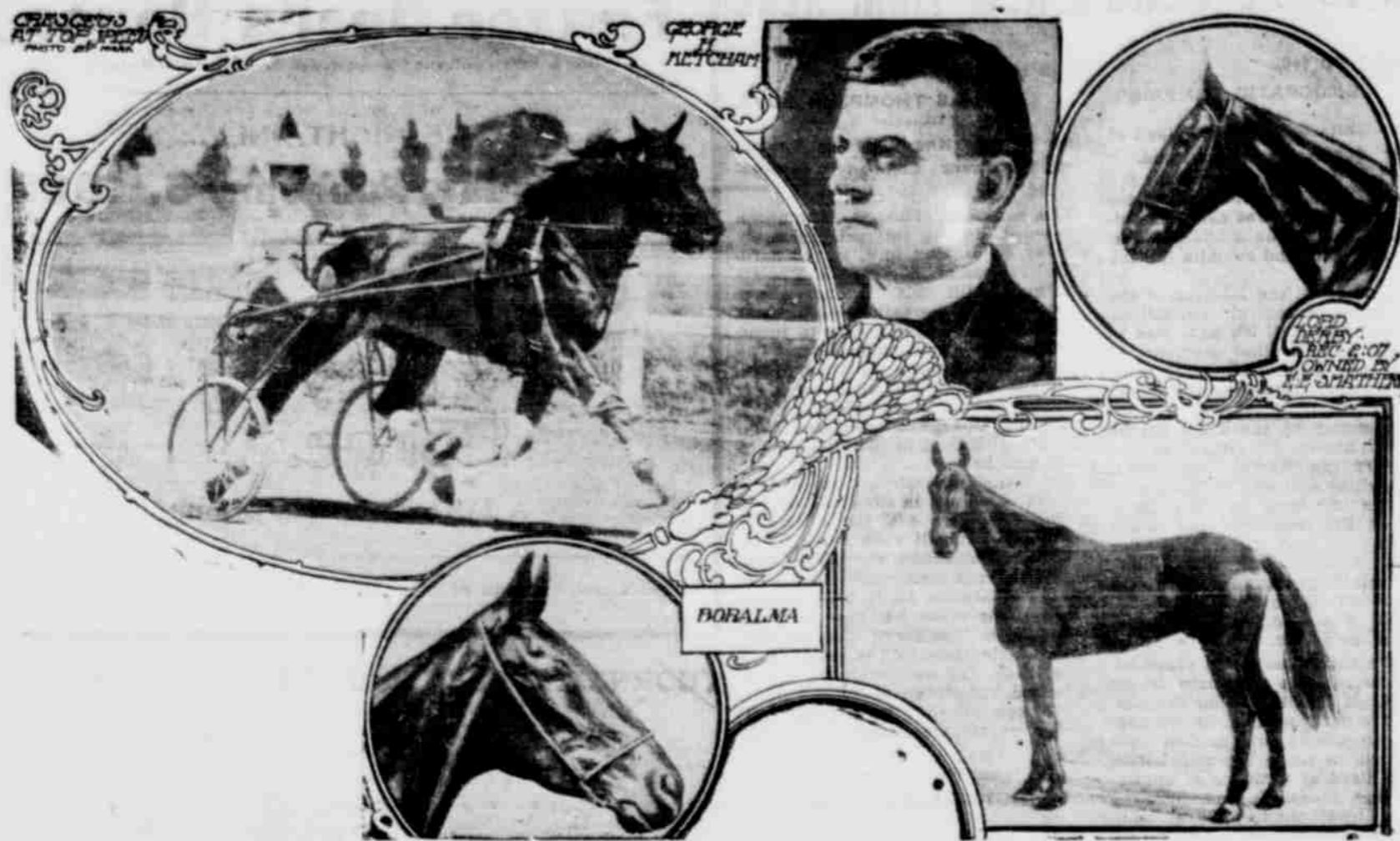

## COST OF OFFICES

### RE-STATEMENT OF STATE SALARY ISSUE.

Figures Compiled by Salem Journal in Fight for Fee System.

The Salem Journal has revised, although not essentially changed, the figures of the cost of state offices, arguing for the adoption of the fee system in place of the present exorbitant receipts of the officials. The showing is as follows:
