THE PIONEERS' BIG PICNIC

FOUR DAYS' GATHERING OF OLD-TIMERS AT WESTON.

Pioneers of Umatilla County Are Enjoying Themselves in the Good, Old-Fashioned Way—Music, Speaking and Ball Games.

The Pioneers of Umatilla county began the four-days' picnic of their annual reunion at Weston this morning, and it is announced that the present reunion is to continue longer have more distinguished speakers present, introduce more unique features and have more people in attendance than any of the previous seven gatherings.

Today Judge A. S. Bennett of The Dalles, delivered the annual address to the pioneers, and in the afternoon there will be a baseball game between teams from Walla Walla and Pendleton.

On Thursday, Rev. H. H. Marvin will preach the memorial sermon, and the afternoon will have another ball game between Walla Walla and Pendleton.

On Friday a number of addresses commemorative of Memorial day will be given by various pioneers and the Weston and Milton baseball teams will cross bats in the afternoon.

Saturday, the final day, will be devoted entirely to politics and spent after the old fashion, listening to stump speeches. George E. Chamberlain, of Portland, and William J. Furnish, of Pendleton, candidates for governor, are expected to be present as well as several other state candidates, while the county candidates will attend in a body, and all will electioneer, for the pioneers are old-fashioned men who adhere to the political methods of 40 years ago. In the afternoon the Pendleton Indians and the heavy Colfax team will meet on the diamond.

Music will abound throughout the four days, Whitman college glee club, Weston quartet, Kirkman's orchestra, Athena band and soloists having been secured. A huge pavilion has been erected, where the speeches will be made and the gray-haired pioneers will tell the stories of the plains. Numerous other features will be given, including a drill by the public school children and public dancing at the pavilion.

WESTON BUSY.

Everything is Lively at That Town These Days.

Weston, May 27.—Everybody is busy in Weston these days. The speakers pavilion was put up this morning. The dancing floor will be finished by night, and three merry-go-rounds will be ready for business some time today.

Tomorrow's program includes the annual address by Judge Bennett, or The Dalles. Several other addresses by pioneers and a baseball game between the Walla Walla Sharpshooters and the Pendleton Indians.

Dr. C. J. Smith, Dr. T. M. Henderson and W. D. Hanford, democratic candidates for state senator, county coroner and treasurer, respectively, passed through Weston today on their way to Fletcher's mill, eighteen miles east of here on Weston mountain.

Mr. John L. Taylor, of Eugene, is spending a few days in Weston visiting his son, Charles Taylor, of the Fair store.

THE DIVORCE COURT.

Evidence Heard in Two Cases Where Couples Were Ill-Mated.

Evidence was heard by District Judge W. R. Ellis Tuesday in two divorce cases. They were Sarah E. Caplinger vs. John Caplinger, and Robert E. Porter vs. Melvina E. Porter.

In the first suit the court ordered that defendant pay plaintiff \$300 within the next 10 days to defray the expenses of the suit, \$50 for attorney fees and beginning with the first of July, \$50 each month until further orders of the court. The decree was not granted in this case.

A decree was granted in the Porter vs. Porter case and the only conditions were that the three children be allowed to live with either plaintiff or defendant and maintained by the one they chose to live with.

Mr. Chandlen says Canyon City is forward to this year as being one of the most prosperous seasons in the history of the country.
