MR. STRAIN CORRECT.

The Assessment of a Valuable Block in Pendleton is as he Stated It.

Pendleton, Or., May 28. (To the Editor.)-I charge that assessment and taxation in Umatilla county is not equitable or fair. Some property is assessed too high and other very much too low. I have cited cases of too low valuations, placed upon property by Assessor George Buzan candidate on the republican ticket for re-election, notably that of the railroad corporations, which are assessed at something like 10 cents on the dollar, and the Byers mill block in Pendleton and others. On the tax roll for 1901 this block, on which the big brick mill building, and three big warehouses are situated, is assessed at \$1000 for the land of the block and \$10,000 for the improvements, or a total of \$11,000 for the entire block and the brick mill buildings and warehouses. valuation of this property is fully \$100,000 and a fair assessment compared to the assessed valuation of other property in Pendleton and other parts of the county would be \$30,000. I am told that Mr. Byers admits that his property is under-assessed compared with other property but that he was not aware of it until recently, when his attention was called to it. In any event the tax rolls in the sheriff's office are as I have stated them here, as can be verified by a visit to that office.
