CITIZENS OF WALLA WALLA ARE WORRIED. Strong Possibility of the Road Being

Made a Branch Line of the Northern Pacific.

The citizens of Walla Walla are onsiderably worked up over the pos sibility of losing the W. & C. R. of ficials and general office in case of the swallowing up of this line by the Northern Pacific. At the present time the general manager, treasurer, chief engineer, freight and passenger done away with, which will mean a loss to the town of not less than \$28,-000 per annum. In addition to the above officers the road superintendent, and several train crews are lo-

cated at Walla Walla. The crews will go with the other officers, but the road superintendent may remain as the present line of the W. & C. R. from Dayton to Pendleton contains 175 miles and this, added to the work of the present superintendent of the Northern Pacific would in all probability, make more than he would be able to handle.

The above sum given as an actual loss to the city of Walla Walla does not include the material for repair work that is purchased annually. The value of this material alone would be quite an item. It is also thought that the repair shops at Hunt's Junction and the office of train dispatcher would be done away with by the movement rumored.
