FOR A FLY-CASTING CONTEST
PROPOSITION TO HAVE SUCH
A TOURNEY IN OREGON.

Planned to Have a Contest on Similar
Lines to the One to Be Held in San
Francisco.

Why not have a fly-casting tour-
nament somewhere in Oregon?

This is one of the sports bills for
San Francisco followers of Isaac
Walton in Golden Gate Park, on the
8th and 9th of August.

Pendleton has a great many lovers
of this sport and no doubt a fly-cast-
ing tourney could be made a success
here. In fact, one is talked of for
next year but that is a long way off.
Why not have one on a small scale
yet this season?

The tourney at San Francisco in
August is to be under the auspices of
the Fly-Casting Club. The con-
test will be for the world's champion-
ships in fly-casting and in lure cast-
ing and will be open to all recognized
angling clubs. The events will be:

1. Long-distance fly-casting with
light rod. Rods not to exceed 5
ounces in weight, with 3/4 of an ounce
allowance for solid reel seat.

2. Long-distance fly-casting with
heavy rod. Weight unlimited.

3. Accuracy fly-casting at buoys 50,
55 and 60 feet. Rods not to exceed
8 1/2 ounces.

4. Combined delicacy and accuracy
fly-casting at buoys 35, 40 and 45 feet.
Rods not to exceed 5 3/4 ounces.

5. Lure casting at buoys 60, 70, 80,
90 and 100 feet. The lure will be a
3/4-ounce rubber frog.

6. Team contest between clubs.
Two men constitute a team. The
events included in the team contest
will be those above described under
heads 2, 3, 4 and 5.

No rod shall exceed 11 feet in
length. All casting to be done single-
handed. Leaders are to be of a sin-
gle gut, and shall be between 6 and
9 feet in length. Fly shall not be
larger than No. 5, American size.

No restrictions on line or reel, ex-
cept that in lure-casting reel shall be
absolutely free-running.

Valuable medals and prizes will be
offered, as well as trophies for team
work. It is proposed at this time
also to form a National association.
Amongst the advantages to be derived
from such an organization are the

adoption of a uniform code of laws
and rules to govern tournaments, the
influencing of legislation for the pro-
tection of fish, the promotion of sci-
entific angling, the formation of clubs
throughout the union, etc.

At this preliminary meeting any
recognized club in the United States
may be represented by proxy, if it
be impossible to send a member as
a delegate.

The president of the San Francisco
club has written to the Oregon Fish
and Game Association, strongly urg-
ing it to have representation at this
tournament. He writes that they pro-
pose to meet in Portland when the
Lewis and Clark fair is held here,
and hold a world's tournament under
the auspices of the association.

It is hoped by the sportsmen of
Oregon that several will be able to
attend the tourney at San Francisco.
At this time the K. P.'s will be hold-
ing a convolve there and rates will
be given over all roads.

It is argued by the local sports that
nothing will stimulate interest in fly-
casting as an art quicker and faster
than to adopt these tournaments.

If something of this kind could be
gotten up locally it would be a good
start toward reviving interest in the
proposition and give people an idea
of what it is to be.
