In speaking of the raise, E. W. McCormas, representing the Northwestern Warehouse Company, said this morning that there was apparently no reason for the raise, more than that the sacks were in a combine...

The farmers have to have sacks and if they were 10 cents it would cut the number consumed very little. Six cents is a good price for grain bags...

A Way to Escape. There is only one way for the farmers to get away from the sack combine...

Binding twine has also advanced to 15 cents a pound, which is the highest it has ever been in this country. However, this does not affect the farmers here, as little binding twine is used.
