PENDLETON TRADE

BUSINESS GROWING TO THE CASH BASIS.

More Farm Produce Coming to Mar-
ket Than Ever Before—Country
Districts Paying More Heed to
Small Items of Income.

"There is less credit trade carried
on in Pendleton than in any other
town of its size in Oregon," said a
prominent business man to an East
Oregonian representative, today.

"The entire business of the city is
growing nearer and nearer to a cash
basis each year. I find that the peo-
ple who formerly ran large accounts
with our merchants are now paying
cash, to a great extent, and are reap-
ing a benefit from it, as are also the
merchants.

"The credit business is ruinous to
any man or institution, but at the
same time, it is one of the great de-
velopments of the age, and has served
a good purpose.

"In a country of diversified interests
like Umatilla county, it seems that
a cash basis could be established and
maintained. Some of the many re-
sources of the farm and range should
furnish ready cash with which to
meet the needs of the community.

"Farmers don't enjoy going in debt,
and business men certainly prefer to
do away with the great expense of
bookkeeping.

"One of the most promising facts
in the trade of Pendleton is the
gradual increase of farm produce
from the outside points in the county.
More butter, eggs and fowls are be-
ing marketed this year than ever be-
fore."

CONTINUE TO RUN TRANSPORTS.

Ludington Advising House Commit-
tee Against Contract System.

Washington, D. C., Dec. 17.—Quar-
termaster General Ludington, of the
army, before the house committee on
military affairs advocates continuing
the transport service under the con-
trol of the war department. He said
the cost of the service as now con-
ducted is about \$3000 less than any
of the estimates submitted by private
concerns, but said that in his opin-
ion it would be in the interest of the
soldier and service for the war depart-
ment to operate "its own line. Gen-
eral Ludington, speaking of the mat-
ter of carrying private parties on the
government transports, said the num-
ber was insignificant and that where
abuses had occurred in that direction
they already had been corrected.

Syracuse, N. Y., Dec. 16.—Summer
resort hotelkeepers of New York
state, at a meeting here today, took
preliminary steps for the formation
of an association which will endeavor
to secure an amendment to the law
which provides for local option towns.
The measure will provide that hotels
in towns that have voted absolute
prohibition under the local option act
may sell liquor, and that in future
no such question shall be put to a
vote of the people.
