## VERY PROSPEROUS

MEACHAM CREEK HAS MANY PROGRESSIVE FARMERS

More Hay Than Usual—Soil Is Very Rich and Easily Irrigated—Fine Fruit and Alfalfa Raised.

Seymour Swauger, of Wilbur Station, on Meacham Creek, is in the city today making holiday purchases. Mr. Swauger reports a heavy snow fall in the Blue Mountains. It is the earliest heavy snow that has laid on any length of time for several years. Stock is doing well on Meacham Creek, many of the farmers and small stockmen having raised more hay than usual this year.

In the rich creek bottoms of the Meacham Creek canyon many of the most prolific small farms of Umatilla county are located.

The soil is very rich and the banks of the creek being low, admit of irrigation.

Alfalfa, fruit and all kinds of vegetables grow in abundance on these mountain farms.

Among those who have cleared off the underbrush and made homes in these fertile spots are J. Swart, E. J. Wilbur, Seymour Swauger, H. W. Swart and Theo. Harm, who has recently moved to Grand Ronde.

The best stock range in Eastern Oregon lies adjacent to this settlement and the idle land along the creek is being gradually improved. There is a school house at Wilbur, but the nearest postoffice is at Meacham, 15 miles farther up the mountain.

### GRAND ATHLETIC EXHIBITION.

Sparring, Wrestling and Bag Punching at Hendricks Hall Christmas Evening.

A grand athletic exhibition will be given at Hendricks hall tomorrow evening, commencing at 5 o'clock.

The entertainment will be strictly moral and can be attended by ladies as well as gentlemen and should not be classed with prize fighting and rough sports.

The program includes an eight-round sparring contest between James Lavigne, of Michigan, and Charles Shockey, of Pendleton.

Professor Lavigne will give a three-round exhibition of fast and fancy bag-punching. A scientific wrestling match and several preliminary sparring bouts by local talent.

### BARB WIRE PHONES.

Farmers Near Spokane Form a Telephone System With a Central Office at Freeman.

Spokane, Dec. 24.—The farmers of the Mica district, in the southeastern part of this county, have formed a telephone syndicate, known as the Richland Telephone Company, and have made arrangements for placing 120 instruments among the families of that neighborhood.

In place of the regular telephone wire the barb wire fences are utilized. The whole country teams with them and consequently there is no difficulty in running the line. Already there have been about 20 'phones installed, with a central office at Thomas' store at Freeman, with a switchboard there. With this arrangement a farmer in one section of the district can call up a resident of another part without the least trouble or inconvenience. It is the intention of the syndicate to establish a central office at Mica and connect with Spokane and Palouse.
