For the past several months the Indians have been coming to town, getting drunk and making themselves a nuisance and having to be locked up. This is becoming tiresome and the present step by the council is intended to eradicate it as much as possible. The Indians give the police more trouble than the whites. They manage to get hold of whiskey and it takes but little to make them trouble-When drunk they are boistersome. ous and the only thing to do with them is to throw them in jail. This costs the city many dollars in the course of a month and little revenue is brought in by them as they seldom have any money with which to pay fines. When arrested they have to be committed to jail where they are fed at the city's expense,
