Future Admirals to Graduate. Washington, Jan. 31.—President Roosevelt, Secretary of the Navy Moody and other public men. including prominent officers of the navy and members of congress, will go to Annapolis Monday to attend the grad-uation exercises at the United States naval academy. The first class, composed of 52 midshipmen, will receive their diplomas from Secretary Moody.
