NOT FOR MR. WOOD

JAS. H. RALEY WOULD GET SENATORIAL TOGA.

Senator Mitchell's Serious Illness Arouses Speculation — Closest Friends do Not Know His Condition.

Oregon politicians are very much interested in the state of Senator Mitchell's health, says the Oregonian. Many suspect that the senator is not giving out information of his true condition. If the senator is mortally sick, not even his closest friends know it. In his letters to his political trustees he has said that he has no organic trouble and that he will be abroad again in a few days. But there is no denying that the senator has been a very sick man.

Gossips have been speculating about the succession to the senatorship, should the appointment of a new senator fall to Governor Chamberlain. It is known beyond any doubt that the governor would not appoint C. E. S. Wood, who was nominated according to the Mays law, in the democratic convention last year. The governor is reported to have said to one of his close political brethren, who asked whether Mr. Wood might be honored with the senatorial toga:

"Never fear, he wouldn't be the man."

The governor really means what he says. There is no close cordiality between him and Mr. Wood, and the two gentlemen, though nominally in the same party, are separated by a breach. This lack of sympathy between them is said to have run back some years. It was strengthened last May, when Mr. Wood, in an interview with a newspaper correspondent at Ashland, condemned right roundly the campaign methods of the democrats. He did this though he was himself on the democratic ticket as a candidate for the United States senatorship. The bond between the governor and Mr. Wood was still further weakened last January when Mr. Wood advised the democratic members of the legislature not to vote for himself but for Mr. Geer for United States senator. But the democrats refused to take up with his suggestion. They voted for him from first to last, not because they loved him more than a republican but because they wished to preserve the integrity of democratic principles and organization.

The man who, it is understood, would be the governor's choice is James H. Raley, of Pendleton, or A. S. Bennett, of The Dalles. Both are able lawyers and men of character. Whether they would accept is doubted by many persons. Acceptance of the appointment would not put either in an enviable position, because he could
