SOCIALISM GROWS

GERMAN PARTY WILL CAST 3,000,000 VOTES THIS YEAR.

Some of the Demands That Are Included in Their Platform—Professional Men Are Flooding to the Socialist Fold in Europe.

New York, June 2.—The socialist democratic party of Germany, which is expected to show increased strength in the coming elections, is the only German party which has grown without a pause for the past 20 years.

The socialist democratic vote in the past six general elections has risen in this fashion:

Table with 2 columns: Year, Votes. 1881: 312,000; 1884: 550,000; 1887: 763,100; 1890: 1,427,000; 1893: 1,786,700; 1898: 2,107,076.

The socialists polled 6.12 per cent of the total vote in 1881 and 27.18 per cent in 1898. They cast 50 per cent more votes at the last election than any other party, and yet, owing to the unfair apportionment, their 2,107,100 voters have only 57 seats in the reichstag against 102 seats for the 1,455,100 voters of the next most numerous party, the center.

The present socialist democratic platform is not what we should call socialist, but rather advanced liberal. Its demands are: 1. One vote for every man and woman; a holiday on election day; payment of members of parliament.

2. Responsibility of the government to parliament; local self-government and the referendum. 3. Substitution of militia system for great standing army.

4. Freedom of speech and the press. 5. Legal equality of the sexes. 6. Disestablishment of the churches. 7. Free non-sectarian schools, with compulsory attendance.

8. Gratuitous legal proceedings. 9. Free medical attendance and burials. 10. Progressive income and inheritance taxes.

The social democrats are distinguished by the high personal integrity of their leaders. According to Mr. Eitzbacher, they form "by far the best led, best managed and the most homogeneous party in Germany."

It is expected that at the next election an immense number of bankers, merchants and professional men of liberal views will vote the socialist democratic ticket.

As candidates for the reichstag must have an absolute majority of all votes cast before there can be a choice, it was necessary to vote again in 48 per cent of the constituencies at the last election.

Heretofore all the other parties have been accustomed to combine against the social democrats in these second polls. This will not happen again, and there seems reason to expect that in the next reichstag there will be at least a hundred social democratic members, elected by 3,000,000 voters.
