CATTLE SITUATION

FOURTEEN CARLOADS WILL BE SHIPPED THIS MONTH.

Importation of Southwestern Cattle and the Finishing Off of Local Fed Animals for the Market Responsible for the Slump in Price of Beeves on the Hoof.

Fred Phillips will ship five carloads of cattle to Carstens Brothers, of Seattle on Monday next, and four carloads on Wednesday. He also has five cars contracted with Gibson, to be delivered at Kenwick on the 20th of this month.

Four of the cars were bought of Rinehart, three of Brigham and two of Rouch Brothers; some were also purchased from Sutzler. This is the shipment of Monday and Wednesday. The stock market, both as regards cattle and hogs, has almost hit the bottom of the price bucket. Some of the stock bought in the recent sales only brought \$4.35 as a top figure, and around this figure it hovers above and below, as the condition of the cattle varies. Only a month or less ago the quotation scaled from \$4.25 to \$4.75, and cattle were scarce at that. Now all kinds of stock can be bought at \$4.25@4.35.

Influenced by Importation.

This fact is due in great measure to the importation of Southern beef to fill the shortage. Perhaps a month ago there may have been a shortage or at least the growers did not consider their stock ready for the buyer, hence the market kicked the beam. The buyers did not feel justified in paying the prices asked and went elsewhere. They bought cheap cattle in California, Texas and even in New Mexico and Indian Territory, and shipped them in. The hole in the demand was filled and naturally the price in the local market fell. Or it might be that the Oregon producers saw that they could not hold out against the cheap beef of the South and decided to let their stock go for what was offered instead of trying to force the market.

But whatever the reason, the market is low, and all the buyers have no difficulty in filling their orders.

Local Herds in Good Condition.

The cattle, too, are in good condition. There is a large number of growers who have fed hay until grass came, and then turned their herds out on green ranges to finish for market. As a result, the beef is fat and sweet and in good demand. But they waited too long to get the prices out of the branches of the market tree; they are sprouting now down in the reach of all.

The monks barricaded the gates and doors of the monastery with paving stones, but the soldiers climbed the walls and gained access to the building. They then cleared away the barricade and arrested the monks and a number of manifestants.
