He was born in Chester county, Pa. in 1845. His first outlined study of architecture was at the Lawrence Scientific School at Harvard University in 1866 and 1867. He then went to Paris and 1867. to Paris and spent three years at the Fetor des Beaux arts. Soon after that he returned to New York and became a member of the well-known firm with which he is still connected. He is the designer of the Columbia University buildings, the public library of Boston and other prominent build-ings throughout the country.
