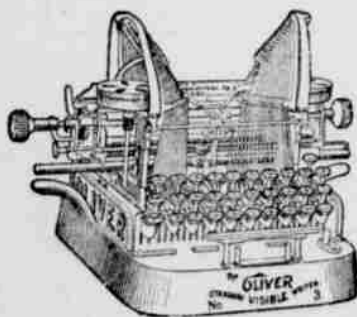

PIONEER FOUND DEAD.

William Ellis, of La Grande, Discovered in a Lodging House Dead.

La Grande, June 22.—About 3:30 o'clock yesterday afternoon William Ellis, an old-time resident of this city, was found dead in a room in the lodging house of C. L. Thorne, on Fir street. Mr. Ellis was well known in this city, having come to La Grande in the early '70s. He had many friends in this community and was known throughout the mining districts of Eastern Oregon as an expert miner. He went to Alaska several years ago, and at the time of his death held mining interests in Cook's inlet, to which northern district he had made four trips.

Mr. Ellis was 62 years of age and was born near London, England. He served in the 49th New York during the late rebellion.

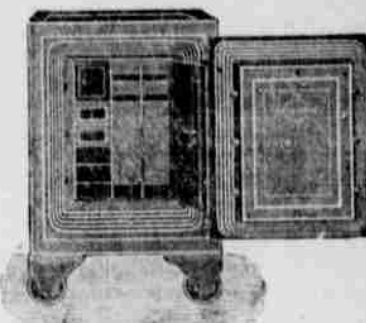
