CUTICURA SOAP FISH AND GAME LAW

SHORT SYNOPSIS OF

OREGON'S STATUTES.

Folders Containing Brief Review Will Soon Be Issued by Secretary of Oregon Fish and Game Association for Use of Sportsmen.

The following synopsis of the fish and game laws of Oregon has been prepared by A. E. Gebhardt, secretary of the Oregon Fish and Game Association and will soon be issued by the association in a neat folder for distribution among sportsmen and others throughout the state, so that all may have an opportunity to acquaint them-selves with the provisions of the law without consulting the statute books.

Much care and attention have been given to the preparation of this epi-tome, in order to condense it into the smallest possible space, and at the same time furnish every necessary deentire state, and to prevent its being used for advertising or other commercial purposes it has been copyrighted by the author:

Upland Birds.

Limit-Ten birds in one day, There are provisions against trapping, netting, ensuaring, robbing nests and placing of poisoned wheat, and against trespass, which apply to all sections of the state,

Sale of grouse, pheasants and quall is permitted during the last 15 days of the open season, subject, however to the restrictions placed upon hunt ing in the different sections of the state. A record must be kept of each

English or gray partridge, caper-calizie, moorhen, wild turkey, wood-cock, silver pheasant, golden pheas-ant, green Japanese pheasant and Reeves pheasant—closed until Octo-ber 1, 1905.

Prairie chicken grouse, native pheasant or ruffled grouse, ring-neck-ed or China torquatus pheasant, quall. Bob White—closed from December 1 of each year to October 1 of the following year.

Wasco county-Prairie chickens and quall-closed from October 15 of each year to August 1 of the following year, and at all times when the ground is covered with snow suffi-cient for tracking.

East of the Cascade mountains (ex-East of the Cascade mountains (except Wasco county—Pheasant (except native pheasant or ruffled grouse) and quali (except Bob White quali)—closed at all times. Sagehen, sagecock, grouse, native pheasant or ruffled grouse—closed from November 1 of each year to August 1 of the following year. Prairie chicken—closed until August 15, 1903; then closed from November 15 of each year to August 15 of the following year. to August 15 of the following year. White quall (except in Klamath and Lake counties)—closed uncil Oc-tober 15, 1905; then closed between December 1 of each year and October 15 of the following year.

There are many special provisions in the law for different sections of the state, which cannot all be given here. The following are a few of

the most important: Columbia river—West of the confluence with the Deschutes river; Unlawful to take or fish for salmon by any means whatever between 6 a. m. on the first day of March and 6 a. m. on the 15th day of April, or between 6 a, m. on August 15th and 6 a, m. on September 10. East of the confluence with Deschutes river: Unlawful to fish for salmon at any time, by any means whatever, except with hook and line; and it is untawful to fish for salmon by any means whatever during the spawning sense sonson, on any spawning
