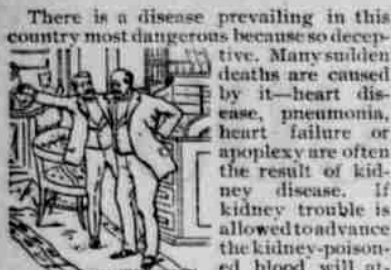

**TELEPHONES IN MINES.**

Use in Underground Work is Steadily Increasing.

Gradually the mines of this and other countries are being equipped with telephones above and below ground. However, there are a number of mines already equipped, but these are with telephones made after their own suggestions. The one great feature being a dry box. But two telephone companies in the United States are known to make a strictly mine telephone and it is probable that these companies will, by their progressive ideas secure a permanent hold upon this coming extensive and profitable additional demand for 'phones.—The Mining World.

**Did Pigeon Cross Pacific?**

Has a carrier pigeon the endurance to fly from Asiatic waters to Salt Lake City? says the Herald. This is the problem that was presented to local experts a few days ago. Mrs. Kate Wiley was aroused by hearing a tapping on her back door. The noise ceased for a moment and then it was renewed. Under the carrier's wings salt was caked. Its feathers were also dotted with hardened brine or spray. The English warship Alliance is now in Asiatic waters.
