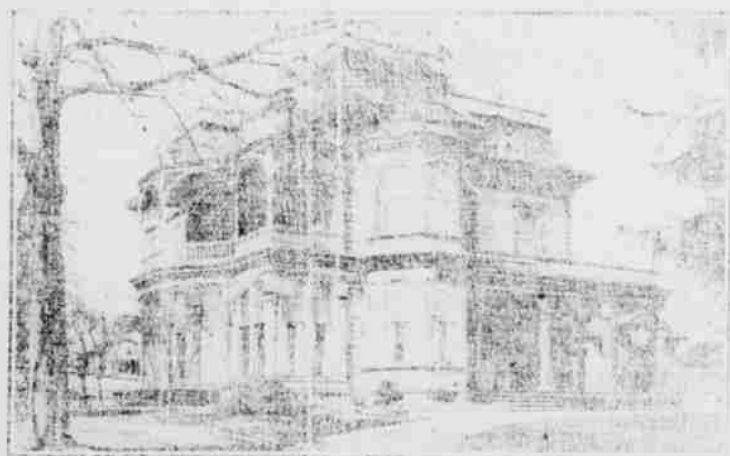

## BOILERS EXPLODE

TWO UNION PACIFIC LOCOMOTIVES BURST UNDER STRAIN.

O. R. & N. Engines of Same Class Are Perfectly Constructed—Severe Tests of Constant Work Brings Out No Structural Weaknesses.

The recent explosion of two locomotive boilers on the Cheyenne division of the Union Pacific causes railroad men to wonder if the compound engines now being received by the Union Pacific are poorly constructed, or whether the two explosions within 10 days on the same class and make of engine are purely accidental.

Engines 1516 and 1512, Baldwin compounds, exploded their boilers the same week near Cheyenne, and as a result 20 firemen working out of Cheyenne quit their jobs in fear of further casualties.

The compound engines in use on the mountain division of the O. R. & N. have been put to the most thorough tests and have stood the strain. They carry 200 pounds of steam constantly, while working, and often in the rush of business are given just as slight repairs as possible in order to keep them moving, and not the faintest evidence of poorly constructed boilers has ever yet been shown.

The explosion of two of the compound boilers on the Union Pacific in one week, seems to be purely accidental. The compounds in use here are the same make and class as those in use on the Cheyenne division and for over a year the 300s and 400s here have been in the harness night and day, with no signs of weak boilers.

The water at places in Wyoming is very destructive on boilers and eats away the iron rapidly. This may account for the accidents to these engines.

Since the O. R. & N. has been in operation, a locomotive boiler explosion has not marred the record. All kinds and classes of engines have been in use and at times they have been worked unmercifully hard to keep traffic moving but no boiler has ever yet failed to carry her pressure under all circumstances.

One blessing on the O. R. & N., which is not enjoyed by many other Western roads is an excellent quality of water at all points along the line.

With the exception of the supply at Purkee, 20 miles west of Huntington, which contains more or less acid, the system can boast of an excellent quality of water. This is a great saving on the strength and endurance of locomotive boilers and the lack of good water on the Union Pacific may be responsible for the accidents.

The engineers on the O. R. & N. are not in the least agitated over the happenings on the Union Pacific and feel that the engines furnished by the company are as safe as any in the United States.

# "The Breakers"

## Where to Stop at North Beach

The Breakers Hotel is conducted to attract the best patronage and is a summer hotel that is unsurpassed on the Pacific Coast north of the famous California beach resorts.

The building has an ocean front of 100 feet, is 76 feet wide and four stories high, or 73 feet from the ground floor to the top of the observatory.

An abundance of fresh and salt water fish, clams, oysters, and other sea food is always on our menu; our entire supply of milk, butter and cream comes from our own herd of Jersey cows and poultry and eggs are supplied from the hotel farm adjacent to the grounds.

There are hot and cold, fresh and salt water baths in the house, with private baths and toilets.

The waves of the ocean at high tide roll within 200 feet of the hotel, and the beach in front is superb for surf bathing.

On the grounds are bowling alleys, golf links, tennis courts, croquet sets; on the lakes, just back of the hotel, is a fleet of rowing boats, and on Shoalwater Bay, just east of the hotel, is a gasoline launch for parties of fishermen, picnickers or others who prefer the warm, still water bathing to the tumbling of the surf.

All trains stop at the railroad station in the hotel grounds, no crowding into hotel omnibuses or walking in sand is necessary since the hotel ground is a perfect velvety lawn, where the cars are practically landed at the hotel door.

The Breakers Hotel is located at Breakers Station, a registered office, where all trains stop. It is one and a half miles from Long Beach Station.

In purchasing tickets see that they read to Breakers, and have baggage checked through to that point.
