Mathews of Spokane, who was here some time ago in the interest of several investors and who went down through Idaho looking for a location, has returned here and says he likes the outlook here better than any he has seen. He had looked over the Vialand, Yakima and Prosser countries before coming here. He has decided to invest here and says he has a number of friends whom he expects will come in a short time.

A number of those who made filings a few months ago are dropping in and building their cabins.

W. W. Wolf, who was here last winter in the interest of a number of Seattle parties, returned a few days ago in company with F. W. Crafts and C. E. Barley of that city.

H. F. Connor, of Portland, came in this morning and drove out to his Blue mountain ranch.

J. H. Strohm, of Seattle, has been here for some weeks looking over the country. He is well pleased with the outlook and expects his father here today. He says they will both likely locate here.

The O. R. & N. will commence in a few days the laying of heavy steel rails from two miles above this station to Umatilla a distance of 20 miles. This means the employment of a number of men. In fact, there is considerable demand for laborers here now.

The American Haze Packing and Cold Storage Company have placed an order for lumber and material for the cannery with the Echo Land and Improvement Company. They say they will be ready to begin canning rabbits by September 1, next.

The Van Cleave Water Hoist.

T. B. Van Cleave has been spending several days in Pendleton where he is raising the fittings for his water lifting machine, which he recently had patented. It is said by those who are using the few machines he has put out that it will lift water from any depth more cheaply than any machine on the market. Mr. Van Cleave will enlarge his building and go to manufacturing on an extensive scale as soon as he can complete his preliminary arrangements. This promises to be one of the leading industries of Echo within a short time. The machine consists of a large barrel or tank with an automatic trip and adjuster, and can be operated either with horse power or steam. It was invented by hand, a few machines some months ago to fully test them. Finding the success with which they met, he suspended the manufacturing and went to work through a Chicago house to improve and perfect his model and the purchase and erection of the machinery necessary to make them on an extensive scale.

He thinks he will be able, in a short time, to build a machine in a day.
