FIRST OF THIS YEAR'S GRAIN CROP BROUGHT IN.

Seattle Contractor Will Begin a Building at Once—Portland Man Here to Make Investments — Thirty Car Loads of Echo Horses Will Be Shipped to Canada.

Echo, Or., Aug. 2.—C. B. Wade came down this morning and drove out to look after his interests here.

N. C. Maris and family, of Portland, came in this morning. He is figuring on investing in real estate here. Mr. Maris formerly lived at Heppner, only having moved from there about a week before the disaster. His house was among the first to go down with the flood.

R. F. Strohm, of Seattle, who has the contract for the erection of the buildings of J. H. Koonz, came in this morning and will begin work at once.

W. H. Babb brought in the first loads of grain today that have been hauled this season. The grain was grown just east of town which is the driest part of the country and Mr. Babb says it turned out much better than he expected.

D. C. Brownell came in this morning from a business trip to Pendleton.

G. W. Hunt came in yesterday from his ranch and reports that he has just finished his first crop of alfalfa and will begin the second cutting today. The entire crop will run about 1,500 tons.

Thirty cars of the first shipment of horses for Canada are ordered here for Thursday and will be loaded here on that day by Thomas Sheridan and W. H. Babb.

R. E. Stacks, of Medicine Hat, and W. F. Matlock came down yesterday from Pendleton and returned on the evening train.

Passing of Famous Gambling Club.

Freehold, N. J., Aug. 2.—Phil Daly's famous Pennsylvania Clubhouse, with its gilded domes, at Long Branch, which for years was the finest gambling palace in the United States, and patronized by those who could wager unlimited amounts, was put up for public sale today. The passing of the club is the direct result of the crusade made last July which effectually put a quietus on public gambling at Long Branch. The orchestra, draperies and decorations of the Pennsylvania Club cost more than \$250,000. When the club was closed by the county officials last summer the elder Daly was not included among those indicted. Phil Daly, Jr., was indicted and fined \$1,500. Up to that time the club had been closed but twice since its erection by the late Joe Hoey in the early sixties.

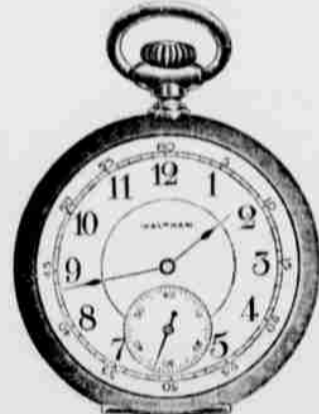
