

Pays Handsome Profits to Farmers, Stimulates Good Road Building and the Growing of Better Forage Crops to Produce Milk.

Within the past two years the dairying business of Union county county. has increased at least twofold. It is estimated that there are now

cream separators owned and operated in the county. Farmers now hand cream from every portion of he county to North Powder and Union, where the creameries are located. Besides the great amount hauled in, hundreds of gallens are cated. shipped by rall from distant points.

Several farmers haul their output as far at 18 miles, making the trip Wice: n week. The separator has eeen made the greatest producer of truffits of any small invention of the farm. The farmer separates his milk farm. and cream at home, the small bulk pure cream making the task. delivery simple and convenient. can of 20 gallous' capacity will The can of 20 gallons capacity will hold the cream from three days milk-ing on 12 cows, and the skimmer milk can be used each day to feed pigs, calves and chickens.

Almost every farmer in the coun-13 is now furnishing cream to one of the creameries and men who heretofore would not handle any enterprise less than a 160-acre farm, are milking from four to six cows at a hand-The output of the creameries finds ready market in the mines of Baker

county and much of it is shipped to Portland, and more would be shipped here if cheaper rates could be se-

In the winter season the creameres have been compelled to run have winter mileh cows and impassable roads, but it is the intention of the dairy and creamery people to estabish winter routes and prepare enough good cows to keep the creameries running all winter.




