



Cheisen, Mass., Aug. 14.—Arrange-ments are being completed for the re-moval of the naval magazine here, which is in dangerous proximity to a which is in dangerous proximity to a thickly populated district, and ship-ping it to a point within samy reach of the Charleston Navy Yard, which has not yet been announced. It will has not yet been announced. It will supply both the Charleston and the Portsmouth yards, and will accom-modate 1.000 tons of explosives. At least a square mile of coast land in least a square mile of coast land in a sparsely settled district having a mile of water front will be seized for the purpose, under condemnation proceedings. A site had previously been selected on Cape Cod, but the owner demanded \$3,000,000 for land worth less than \$50,000 when he learned the purpose for which it was wanted.
