SEATTLE COMPANY BE-GINS CONSTRUCTION WORK.

Central Each Year Until 420 Miles Are Built-From Knik to Eagle.

One of the most important expe difficus that ever left this city for Amster goes north on the Pacific Anaska goes north on the Pacific Clipper line steamer Santa Ana, which is scheduled to sail Monday, says the Sentife Star. TRAFFIC KINGS OF ENGLAND MEET AT MONTREAL.

Must Complete 125 Miles of Alaskan First Convention of the Body Ever Held Outside of Great Britain-Came to Canada at Special Request o fMontreal Chamber of Commerce. Montreal, Que., Aug. 17. Montreal

> this week is entertaining the trade kings of the British empire, the occasion being the arth congress of the chambers of commerce of the empire and the first meeting of the organizaflor ever held outside of Great Britain, When those thin it year ago, the Mon-treal chamber of commerce invited the organization to hold its next meet-ing in Canada it was prodicted that the event would prove of great com-mercial importance to the Dominion.

> The full measure of this importance invoicer, was not appreciated until today, when the gathering was for-mally opened and the visitors officially greated on behalf of the Dominion government, the city of Montreal and Those present included a strong dele-gation representing England and all its varied industries, from the ship-ting interests of London and Liver-pool to all the diversified manufac-tures of the midded counties.

> In addition to these delegates from the mother country there were present representatives of the British chamber of commerce of Paris, of Kimlerley South Africa, or Maseru. Basuteland, of Pori Elizabeth, Cape Colony, or Colombo, Ceylon, and of many other self-governing colonies of the British empire.

> The discussions will begin in earnset tomorrow and will continue through the week. Among the matters to be considered, in addition to fiscal policy, are postal reforms, emigration, and the assimilation of the com-mercial laws of the empire. At the conclusion of the congress the dele-gates will visit Ottawa and afterward
