OLD ENOUGH TO QUIT

EMPEROR OF AUSTRIA IS SEVENTY-THREE YEARS OLD. Thought That He Might Abdicate, But Didn't—Few Men Have Experienced the Amount of Trouble That Has Been His Lot—A Gentle But Opinionated Man.

Vienna, Aug. 18.—The 73d birthday of Emperor Francis Joseph was celebrated in the capital today with a review of troops, decorations of the city and the granting of amnesty to many prisoners serving sentences for minor offenses. It has been persistently rumored or late that the venerable emperor would signalize the day by abdicating the throne of the dual monarchy, but those acquainted with the indomitable though gentle character of the aged monarch never for an instant credited this report.

True, the emperor has experienced enough trouble during the half century he has occupied the throne to crush the spirit of most men. Bereft of those he loved dearest, his only son and heir the victim of a heinous crime, his august consort felled by the stiletto of an assassin, and the heir apparent to the throne, Franz Ferdinand, wedded to a woman of inferior rank, Francis Joseph certainly has been equally unfortunate, though personally he is recognized as one of the wisest and most astute rulers of Europe.

With the spirit of revolt still active in Croatia, the obstructionists turning the meetings of the Hungarian diet into a series of daily riots, and the Austrian parliament struggling to keep in order a band of un-

ruly members who have been encouraged in their obstructive tactics by the Hungarian example, the dual monarchy could not be described as a happy and harmonious whole. But, then, it seldom has been, and the aged emperor must smile at the noises of the pessimists who loudly foretell the dismemberment of his empire and his own abdication when he thinks how many more serious storms he and his country have weathered together in the long years of his reign.

LEGION OF HONOR.

Famous Order Which Was Transplanted From France. Atlantic City, N. J., Aug. 18.—The supreme grand council of the American Legion of Honor assembled here today in biennial session. Each of the delegates wore upon his breast the decoration of the French Legion of Honor, the badge of the famous French order being used by the American organization by special permission of the French government, granted in 1878 to Darius Wilson, of Boston, who was the founder of the order in America. The sessions of the council, which will extend over a week or longer, will be presided over by Supreme Commander William N. Davenport, of Boston.
