PAST WEEK HAS BEEN VERY HARD ON GRASS.

Harvest Under Way All Over Eastern Oregon-Yield Much Better Than Expected-Hops Infected With Lice -Prunes Not Falling so Badly as

A few small showers occurred Sunday in the Willamette valley, but otherwise the past week has been with temperatures averaging slightly above normal. The rains were insufficient to be of much benefit to late crops and pastures, which are now beginning to need rain quite badly. Feed is getting short on the ranges, and the supply of milk is decreasing in the dairy districts. Stock, bowever, continues doing fairly well and cattle, as a rule, are in good flesh An average second crop of alfalfa has been harvested in southern sections. There is some hay yet to be cut in the coast counties but having in general is now completed, with satisfactory yields in all parts of the stare.

The grain harvest is being pushed

everywhere, and in the Willamette and in Eastern Oregon they are much better than expected, although not averaging as heavy as last year. Soring grain ripered under (averable weather conditions, and the heads are

well filled with plump berries The week has been tayorable for loops, and although lice are more numrous than usual, the vines have not been injured to any extent and the prospects are good for yields but slightly below those obtained last ever. Corn has made good progress. and it is now tasseling and earing are potatoes and gardens need rain

Prunes are not dropping so badly they did during the previous week, nd this crop will be an extra good ac. Bartlett pears are also very promising Apples are quite uneven, and it is expected the yields will be ow than the average.
