# **STATISTICS**

REGULAR REPORTS OF BIRTHS AND DEATHS.

Delay Has Been Due to State Printer's Failure to Get Out Blanks-Interesting Outline of Provisions of the New Law-All Contagious and Infectious Diseases Must All Be Reported.

For a long time the state board of health has been held up in its efforts to systematize the vital statistics of the state, by the tardiness of the state printer in getting out the neces-sary blanks for the use of the phy-sicians of the state; but at last that office has got the blanks printed, and some of the county officials have received their share, so that the work will now go on as fast as the arrange-

ments can be made.

According to the rules of the state board every birth and every death must be recorded by the doctor ac-tending, with the county health officer, or the county physician. That official must have all of the cases reported to him by the fifth of the month following the occurrence, and he must in turn file his report with the state board by the tenth of the same month.

same month.

Whenever a child is born in the future, the physician attending will make two reports—one original copy and one carbon copy. The original will be sent to the county physician, or in the absence of that official, to the county Judge. The carbon will be sent to the secretary of the statishoard of health. In this way the statishies will be easily compiled, and tistics will be easily compiled, and track can be kept of the vital statisties of the whole state. In the case of death the same rule holds good.

By the law it is in the power of the county physician to deputize any and all persons following the undertaking business and selling caskets, as dep-ury health officers, and it will be their land. power in remote districts to issue turial permits on the certificate of the spector attending the case or of a house holder who is familiar with the case. This is done to do away with the inconvenience and delay that would custe if the parties had to come to the county seat, or the residence of the county physician, from remain parts of the county in order remote parts of the county in order to obtain permission to bury a person in case of death,

Another thing that will be watched from now on, is the importation of contagious, or infectious disease into the state by any common carrier and the railroads and steamship lines. By the rules of the law it is permissible for the health officer to detain and quarantine any common carrier shall have on board a case of contagious disease, and to hold them in quarantine until the danger of the disease has been passed. It can make the carriers fumigate their vehicles, and the expense will be borne by the

carriers, The state board has been waiting on the state printer since the first of May, but now as the work has been done, no time will be lost in getting

the machinery of the law into effect.

it will be required of all dectors to make full report to the county board of health, consisting of the county judge and the county physician, not-ing all cases of contagious Illness, and all births and deaths. It is also
