

WORLD'S FAIR COMMISSIONER NOW IN PHILIPPINES.

of Government Experts.

By following the voyages of Dr By following the voyages of Dr. Gustave Niederlein, the accentiat in charge of the expedition to the Pub-lippine Islands, commissioned to col-lect and secure exhibits for the World's Pale at St Louis, one will learn that the archipelago is one of magnificent distances, and that Dr. Nanderlein's modertaking is as ciran-Andericin's undertaking is as gigantic as it is interesting.

From Yami Island, the most treme point of the Bataness group north of Lazof, the most important island of the American possessions in the Pacific Ocean, to Manka Island, the most southern and one of least important islands of the Suin group, the distance is more than 1200 miles on a direct line. It is further than from St. Paul to New Orleans or from Kansas City to New York, From the western shore of Halboe Island, off the southern coast Halboe Island, of the Sorri Sanco on of Palawan Island to Port Sanco on the east coast of Mindanao Island, the most eastern extremity of the Filipino lands, it is more than 650 miles, or as far as from St. Louis o Washington.

Manila was the Philippine starting point for one of Dr. Niederlein's voyages in the spring of 1903. Steaming out of Manilla bay the Dr. and the World's Fair party entered and the World's Fair party shlerod the China Sea and passing between Mindoro Island and the Calamianes Isles, proceeded through the Sulu Sea to Puerto Princesa on the east coast of Palawan Island, after hav-ing sailed more than 400 miles. Pal-war, i.e. a strict of mountainous land awan is a strip of mountainous land more than 250 miles long and 50 miles across in the widest place. At one point, near Puerto Princesa, but ten miles of land separate the China and Sulu Seas. The bay at that point contains about 25 square miles, and receives eight rivers from as many different directions. Few natives inhabit the island and the small population is made up of Cuya-

nos, some Tagalogs and Chinese, The export product The export products consist mainly of resins, rattan or bejuco, consist beeswax, pearl shells, pearls and tamber. Dr. Niederlein and his party obtained birds, nests, salt, white walking sticks, beiuco, resins, beeswax, curious native clotns, hats. tobacco, baskets, blow pipes pearls. bolo blades, tuba buckets, rice mor-tars, and other products of the island. 
