### THREE EXECUTED

FATE OF BROTHERS WHO MURDERED THEIR UNCLE.

The Fourth Brother, Implicated Also in the Crime, Escaped Electrocu- tion By Turning State's Evidence— The Youngest of the Trio Is 21 Years of Age—All Were Convicted a Short Time Ago.

Clinton, New York, Sept. 30.—At an early hour tomorrow morning, when the sun is peeping over the hills, beautiful in their autumn foliage, the sombre death chamber of Dannemora Prison will be the scene of one of the most dramatic executions in the annals of New York state. The victims will be the three youthful Van Wormer brothers, Willis, Burton and Frederick, who must die in the elec- tric chair for the murder of their aged uncle, Peter A. Hallenbeck. The few persons that will be admitted within the prison walls to witness the state execute its vengeance for the cold blooded murder of one of its citizens will see three brothers, the youngest scarcely twenty-one, pass, one after the other, to that seat in the grim engine of death. First one of the brothers will be led out, and, after receiving the last rites, will be placed in the chair and shocked into eternity, while the other two, humanely prevented from wit- nessing his death throes, will await their places in the grim procession.

Today the warden and his as- sistants got everything in readiness for the triple execution and experts tested the death apparatus in order to make sure that no accident might occur when the fatal hour arrives. The condemned youths spent the day much in the same way that they have passed the many days of their con- finement in prison. A quiet, stolid reserve has given way to the flippant manner affected by the boys in the earlier days of their imprisonment, but their courage evidently has not deserted them. The authorities ex- pect all of them to meet death calm- ly. They embraced the Catholic re- ligious some time ago and it is prob- able their last hours will be passed in the company of a priest.

The Van Wormer boys were living in Kinderhook, Columbia, on Christ- mas eve, 1901, when they started in a carriage for Greenport, with their cousin, Harvey Bruce. The boys, who were under the influence of liquor, drove to the home of Peter A. Hallenbeck, who was very old, opened the door in response to their knocking, and as he did so, they fired upon him, inflicting wounds from which he died in a short time. At the trial, which lasted about two weeks, the accused youths declared that they went to Hallenbeck's house merely for the purpose of frightening him, with no thought of injuring him. Bruce escaped the chair by turning state's evidence, giving testimony that brought about the conviction of the other three for murder in the first degree.

China Henry, who hang- ed himself in the Heppner jail, said before committing suicide, that Lane fixed up the plan to murder their countryman, when he started to Chi- na, with about \$1,000 in his pockets.
