WAGNER PILGRIMS

MUSIC LOVERS AT BERLIN
FROM ALL OVER THE WORLD.

Monument Erected to the Memory of the Great Composer Will Be Unveiled—Program Includes A Chorus By Two Thousand Adult Voices—International Musical Conference.

Berlin, Sept. 30.—Berlin is filling with music-loving pilgrims from the four quarters of the globe, come to attend the week's festivities attending the unveiling of the Richard Wagner monument. Many Americans are among those gathered to pay tribute to the memory of the celebrated poet-composer. England also is well represented among the visitors.

Great celebrations in honor of war heroes and empire builders have been rather common in Berlin of late years, but seldom or never before in its history has the imperial capital witnessed such a demonstration in honor of one whose fame rests solely on his artistic achievements as that to be held during the next few days. The entire nation is interested in the festivities. The Emperor's person has directed the arrangements and the participation will include many of the leading public men as well as the foremost musicians and composers of the country. The monument to be consecrated tomorrow has been raised from contributions sent from all nations, and therefore invitations have been sent out bidding guests from all the world and masters and disciples from all the world's musical schools. The list of honorary patrons of the festival includes many members of the European royalty and nobility, and many masters of music.

The dedication of the monument will take place tomorrow and will be accompanied by elaborate and imposing ceremonies. Appropriate addresses will be delivered by men of note and the musical portion of the program will be rendered by a chorus of 2,000 adult voices, augmented by a boys' chorus and accompanied by the selected Guards' military bands. The feature of Thursday will be the festival banquet in the great hall of the Winter garden, under the presidency of Prince Frederick Henry of Prussia and Prince Louis Ferdinand of Bavaria. Golden commemorative medals will be presented to the artists participating in the musical festivities. The three succeeding days will be occupied with grand musical performances and gala concerts in which artists of renown will present the masterpieces of the great composer. The climax will be reached Saturday night when by command of the emperor a grand festival performance of "Die Meistersinger" will be given in the Royal Opera House by an ensemble selected from the most celebrated representative Wagner singers.

During the five days of the festival the first international musical conference will be held under the auspices of the International Musical Association, of which Professor Oscar Fleischer, of the Berlin Musical School is the chairman. Special permission has been granted to the congress to hold its sessions in the Reichstag's building.

Fortunes From Cascara.
Nearly \$60,000 in cash is the amount realized from cascara bark purchased and shipped from Benton county this season. Careful compilation and conservative estimates place the exact figures at \$59,400. The product is represented in 27 11-ton cars of bark, either shipped or to be shipped this season. The aggregate weight of the bark was 594,000 pounds. Though much of it went at 14 cents and better, so much left the peelers' hands at 4, 5 and 6 cents earlier in the season that the average price is believed to have fallen at about 10 cents.

Wenatchee Canal Open.
The Wenatchee irrigating and power canal in Chelan county, Washington, was opened Monday. It was intended to reclaim 6,000 acres, but the actual amount reclaimed by it will be less than 1000 acres. It is 23 miles long and cost \$200,000. Next to the Spreckles canal in Hawaii, it is the most costly in the world. The Spreckles canal is but 26 miles long and cost \$360,000.
