ARE ASSESSED TOO HIGH.

Ninety Complaints Are Entered Before Portland Board of Equalization.

Portland, Oct. 9.—Ninety complaints have been made before the board of equalization of Multnomah county against high assessments.

The complaints are nearly all special cases and can be adjusted without calling in question the general assessment of the county.

Most of the complaints are corporations claiming exemptions under different pretexts, many of them on the grounds that some other corporation received less assessment than they. There is no general complaint of the people against the assessment.

Baker City, Oct. 9.—The citizens of Sumpter are circulating a petition to present to the officials of the Sumpter Valley railway, asking for a reduction of freight rates between that city and here.

The shipments of mining machinery and material into the Sumpter district have increased 50 per cent in the past 18 months and many small companies are now holding back in developing their properties on account of the heavy cost of transportation.
