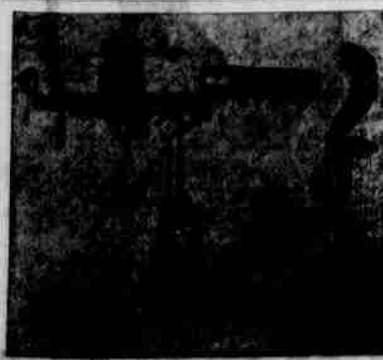

RAISES VALUATIONS

GRANT COUNTY ASSESSMENTS WERE TOO LOW.

Cattle Raised from \$10 to \$12.50 Per Head—Tillable Land Raised \$1.25 Per Acre—Sheep From \$1 to \$1.25 and Other Property in Proportion.

The board of equalization of Grant county met at the court house in Canyon City Saturday, and after hearing all complaints that came before the board the following findings were made:

It appearing to the board after careful examination of the assessment roll for the year of 1903 as returned by the assessor that the said assessment roll is over one-third less than the assessment roll for the year 1902, and unless the assessment be raised to something near the assessment value heretofore placed upon it, that it will require a levy of at least 12 mills in addition to the 31 mill levy of 1902, to defray the running expenses of the county, state, school, bridge and road purposes.

And it further appearing to the board that all classes of property have been assessed at from 30 per cent to 50 per cent less and in some instances a larger per cent than for the year 1902, and it further appearing to the board that all non-tillable land should be raised from 75 cents per acre to \$1.25 per acre; cattle from \$10 per head to \$12.50 per head; sheep from \$1 per head to \$1.25 per head; improvements on all real estate, ditches, town lots and improvements thereon, all timber land from 75 cents per acre to \$2.50 cents per acre, and all classes of personal property other than that heretofore enumerated, including hogs, horses, mules, bank and mining stocks, monies, notes and accounts, merchandise, machinery, telephone lines and all other classes of property should be raised at least one-third or 33 1/3 per cent more than the present assessment as now appears on the roll, and in some instances more; and that the said assessment for the year of 1903, on all classes of property should be raised such an amount.

JACK LONDON RECONCILED.

Sick Child Brings Parents Together Again.

Oakland, Oct. 12.—Jack London, the novelist, and his wife, have been reconciled through the sickness of a little daughter of the couple.

The Londons agreed to separate about two months ago, the prime cause being a passage in one of London's stories, to which Mrs. London objected, as casting reflections upon her life and intellectual capacity.

Yesterday Joan, the 3-year-old daughter, was taken dangerously sick

with pneumonia, and the parents became reconciled at her bedside, although they have lived apart since in July. London is engrossed in writing a new novel and has not visited his wife and two small children since the separation, although they live in a small flat two blocks distant from London's rooms.

Friends think they will live together hereafter, as the causes which led up to the separation were trivial.
