New Road Will Be Built Connecting the Two Places This Fall. Grangeville, Oct. 14.—The discuss-ed projec of building an electric line from Lewiston to Grangeville has at last a tangible shape, and all con-ditions now seem to assure that the great enterprise will be carried out. Colonel Judson Spofford, of Bolse, who is interested in the project, and Engineer Walter H. Hill, will imme-diately view the ground and make the survey. Colonel Spofford's arri-val here a few days ago has disclos-ed the fact that practically all preed the fact that practically all pre-liminary details have already been worked out. Prominent Lewiston and Grangeville men will be the incorporators and abundant capital <sup>4</sup>-promised. In fact, during the past few days \$2,000 in stock has already been subscribed here to assist in preliminary work. Messrs, Spofford and Hill will reach Lewiston the latter part of next week, after having made a trip over the country to be can-vasued by the line. 
