LEWISTON TO GRANGEVILLE.

New Road Will Be Built Connecting the Two Places This Fall.

Grangeville, Oct. 14.—The discussion project of building an electric line from Lewiston to Grangeville has at last a tangible shape, and all conditions now seem to assure that the great enterprise will be carried out. Colonel Judson Spofford, of Boise, who is interested in the project, and Engineer Walter H. Hill, will immediately view the ground and make the survey. Colonel Spofford's arrival here a few days ago has disclosed the fact that practically all preliminary details have already been worked out. Prominent Lewiston and Grangeville men will be the incorporators and abundant capital is promised. In fact, during the past few days \$2000 in stock has already been subscribed here to assist in preliminary work. Messrs. Spofford and Hill will reach Lewiston the latter part of next week, after having made a trip over the country to be canvassed by the line. Further information has not been given out by the promoters at this time.
