## ON LABOR QUESTION

### CIVIC FEDERATION MEETS IN CHICAGO TOMORROW.

It is Expected That Several Hundred Delegates Will Be in Attendance From all Parts of the Country—Former President Cleveland Will be One of the Principal Speakers—Senator Hanna is President.

Chicago, Ill., Oct. 14.—Tomorrow morning at 10 o'clock the conference called by the National Civic Federation to discuss the question of the relations between capital and labor in all its various phases will be called to order in Steinway Hall by Senator Hanna of Ohio. He is president of the federation.

It is expected that several hundred delegates will be in attendance from all parts of the country. The supreme importance of the questions scheduled for consideration has caused extraordinary interest to be manifested in the conference. This interest is evinced by the fact that the Farmers' National Congress and numerous other organizations have asked to be admitted to the conference and their requests have been granted.

Beyond the formalities attendant on the opening of the conference, no attempt at a program has been made and none will be attempted. The work in that respect being left to the conference itself. President Hanna will call the gathering to order and welcoming addresses will be delivered by Mayor Harrison and others. Secretary R. M. Easley will present a report showing the work of the federation during the last year. It is expected that former President Grover Cleveland will be heard on the opening day and his address naturally will be the chief feature.

During the two days it will be in session the conference will discuss the "open shop," restriction of output, strikes, lockouts, wages and hours of labor, conciliation and arbitration. Particular attention will be given to the question of compulsory arbitration in the settlement of labor disputes on street railways, municipal utilities, etc. There will also be a debate on "What shall we do to establish more rightful relations be-

tween workmen and employers? The number of prominent men who are expected to take part in the proceedings is large. Representing the public at large will be Oscar S. Straus, Charles Francis Adams, Archbishop Ireland, Bishop Henry C. Potter, Franklin MacVeagh and James H. Eckels. Employers will be represented by Senator Hanna, John B. McDonald, contractor for the subway in New York; Frederick D. Underwood, president of the Erie Railroad; Edward P. Ripley, S. R. Callaway and Marcus A. Marks. On the part of the part of the wage earners, Samuel Gompers, John Mitchell, James Duncan, Martin Fox, E. E. Clark, William D. Mahon and Dennis Hayes will be present. Alfred Mosely of England, former Governor Francis of Missouri and Thomas F. Woodlock, editor of the Wall Street Journal are also scheduled among the speakers.

### TO IMPROVE OHIO RIVER.

That will be Principal Question at Annual Convention.

Evansville, Ind., Oct. 14.—The ninth annual convention of the Ohio Valley Improvement association opened here today. Several hundred delegates from points in Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Ohio, Pennsylvania and West Virginia were assembled in Evans' Hall, when the gathering was called to order by the president, John L. Vance.

In the opening addresses facts and figures were adduced to show the importance of the Ohio valley as one of the greatest industrial centers in the world, the industrial progress of the region being due in a large measure to the river improvements accomplished during the last twenty years. The present convention will ask the coming session of congress to make sufficient appropriation to complete the survey of the Ohio river to Cairo, looking to locking and damming the river. It is estimated that it will require \$60,000,000 to complete the locks and dams to Cairo insuring a mine-proof stage of water all the year.
