GENERAL NEWS

An arbitration treaty between Britain and the United States is a probability of the near future.

The successes of the Morocco rebellion are so pronounced and continuous that the government is said to be practically on its last legs.

The Indiana state convention of Baptists have memorialized the United States to expel Reed Smoot, the Mormon senator from Utah.

Surgical instrument dealers, manufacturers and importers of Canada and the United States are organizing a trust. There are 300 people in the classes named.

The Charlton steel plant, near Pittsburgh, which has been shut down because of financial difficulties, has been recapitalized for \$2,000,000, and will be reopened soon.

Wall street gossip has it that J. P. Morgan gave H. E. Huntington a "straight tip" in August, which resulted in the latter dropping \$900,000 in cold cash into the hole.

Five men are being tried by court-martial at Fort Leavenworth who mutinied and escaped from the federal prison there two years ago. Seven of the escapes are still at large.

A large number of recently arrived Italians have been furnished with bona naturalization papers in New York City, and put to work on the streets in readiness to be voted at the fall election.

PACIFIC NORTHWEST NEWS

The Oregon Pine Needle factory, now at Grant's Pass will be moved to Summerville, Union county, this year, to be enlarged and operated there.

There are now 15 deep sea vessels in Portland waiting for cargoes of wheat. The supply now in sight is 5,000 tons short of the amount of the cargoes.

Sailors are scarcer in Portland this fall than ever before. Every vessel entering the port is short, and it is impossible to supply the demands from the local offices of the Seamen's Union.
