EPISCOPAL BISHOP

PROMOTION OF A NOTED CONNECTICUT DIVINE.

His Consecration the Occasion for the Assembling of Large Number of Eminent Churchmen and Public Men — Bishop Lines Is 52 Years of Age.

Newark, N. J., Nov. 18.—The Rev. Dr. Edwin S. Lines was consecrated bishop of the Protestant Episcopal diocese of Newark in Grace church today. The services, which began at 10:30 o'clock, were presided over by the Right Rev. Daniel Sylvester Tuttle, bishop of Missouri, and presiding bishop of the Protestant Episcopal church of America, assisted by the co-consecrators, Bishop Scarborough of the New York diocese, and Bishop Potter of New York.

Besides the presiding bishop and co-consecrators the following bishops were present: The presenting Bishops, Bishop Leighton Coleman of Delaware, and Bishop Chauncey D. Brewster of Connecticut; the preacher, Bishop William C. Doane of Albany; the visiting bishops, Bishop Frederick Daniel Huntington of Central New York, and Bishop Satterlee of Washington.

Following the consecration ceremonies at the church a public reception in honor of the new bishop was held in the new Auditorium in Orange street. The reception was attended by several thousand clergymen and laymen. Prominent among those present were Governor Franklin Murphy of New Jersey and Mayor Henry M. Doremus of Newark.

The new Bishop of Newark was born in Naugatuck, Conn., in 1851. He was graduated from Yale University in 1872, and entered Berkeley College, in Middletown, Conn., graduating in 1876. He then took orders and became the curate of Christ Protestant Episcopal church, West-haven, where he remained until 1879, when he was chosen rector of St. Paul's Protestant Episcopal church in New Haven, one of the most important Episcopal churches in Connecticut.

Dr. Lines in 1897 received the degree of doctor of divinity from Yale University. Previous to his election to the Newark diocese he was prominently mentioned for the bishopric of his church in Connecticut.

Former Pendleton Man Being Tried For Murder in Idaho.

Idaho City, Nov. 18.—The trial of H. M. St. Cyr, charged with the murder of Archie Emmons at Lardo, on the Payette lakes, was begun here yesterday evening. The session was taken up with the selection of the jury. The box was filled shortly before court adjourned for the day and the taking of evidence will be begun tomorrow. Thirty-three were examined before a jury was secured. James H. H. way of counsel for the defense, in his opening statement said the defense expected to prove that Emmons went into St. Cyr's home and secured the latter's revolver, from which he fired two shots at St. Cyr, who then secured a rifle and killed him. The prosecution stated it expected to clearly prove the murder charge.
