## SHIPPING MINERS

WYOMING MINES BEING FILLED WITH NORTHERN MEN

Agents of Coal Magnates Quietly Sending Scores of British Columbia Miners to Colorado and Wyoming—Clandestine Movements of the Agents—Filling Strikers' Places.

Spokane, Dec. 1.—The startling news was about today that the coal magnates of Wyoming and Colorado had an agent in this city, who, for the last week, has been hiring men to go to those regions and take the places of the union miners. This man could not be located today. For several days past people have noticed a great many cockneys around the city, who stop over here for a day and then leave over the Northern Pacific on the Burlington train. Most of them get tickets to Wyoming, but their destination is evidently Colorado. These cockneys are a thrifty lot who have spent but a few years or months in this country. Fernie, a coal camp in British Columbia, is where the most of them come from.

While in this city they seldom leave each other, but travel around in a crowd until their train is ready to leave, when they gather their blankets and other belongings and depart.

They are very close-mouthed and although very willing to tell one about British Columbia and their strikes up there, they absolutely refuse to say whither they are bound.

When the question is pressed they maintain it is Montana, but investigation shows they go into Wyoming and Colorado. Fully 100 have passed through the city within the past ten days, and union men who have met them finally became suspicious and investigated as well as they could, with the result as above stated.

That the owners have an agent here has been suspected for some time, but he is such a smooth individual that his identity has not yet been located. From this city he has been operating through British Columbia. It is also stated that many of the cockney miners leave for the South by way of the Jennings branch of the Great Northern, via Havre, Great Falls and Helena.

The regular beats of this rock are unaffected by calms or by tempestuous seas that break completely over it.
