BIG LUMBER COMPANY.

An important Organization Formed in Asotin County. The biggest enterprise that has been consummated in Asotin county for many months was the one that was brought to a head yesterday afternoon, when the Blue Mountain company was organized with a capital stock of \$100,000, says the Asotin Sentinel. Asotin is to be headquarters for this big corporation, with the mills located at Anasone and Lake. The stockholders are William Farish, L. K. Brown, Kenneth McIntosh, D. A. McIntosh, E. Baumeister, Chas. Isreke, E. J. Warner, Perry Loy, Jas. A. H. Charles Florence, Frank Huber, Frank Morrison and A. B. McDonald. Including the purchase of 2,940 acres from G. A. and W. S. Rogers at a cost of \$25,000, this company possesses close to 6,000 acres of the choicest saw timber that is available in eastern Washington. A conservative estimate places the total amount of saw timber close to fifty million feet. Three mills, with a daily capacity of 30,000 feet each, will be operated for the present.

WON'T PAY SUGAR BOUNTY.

Idaho Auditor Refuses to Comply With the Law. For several days there have been many rumors afloat as to what State Auditor Turner would do when claims were filed with him by the sugar beet manufacturers for one cent a pound on sugar manufactured in the state in accordance with the law passed by the last legislature. Mr. Turner was seen today by the Capital News reporter and asked what he would do when such claims were filed. In response to the question, he said: "The matter of the payment of a bounty upon beet sugar in conformity to the provisions of the act passed by the legislature at its seventh session is one of great importance to the people of the state of Idaho. Such payment would establish a precedent for the payment of other bounties and subsidies in the future and would impose upon the people a burden much too great to be assumed hastily or before the validity of the act is properly determined."—Boise Capital News.

FACTORY GRINDING OUT SUGAR

Gibson and Pure Food Inspector Alex McPherson returned yesterday from Idaho Falls, where they tested and inspected the product of the beet sugar factory, in accordance with the provisions of the sugar bounty law. G. H. Wright has been appointed sugar inspector and taster and will hereafter represent the state at the factory. Inspector McPherson found that the Idaho sugar was absolutely pure, testing 100 per cent with the polariscope.

DISEASE OR ACCIDENT.
