ALBERTA MARKET FOR
GOOD JOHN DAY STOCK

C. J. Officer Has Returned to Gather Up Another Shipment for the Same Territory—Was Much Pleased With Alberta and Took Land Therein—A Fine Wheat Country.

C. J. Officer of John Day has returned from a trip to High River, Alberta, Canada, where he went about a month ago with a couple of cars of horses for the market there. He has sold all of his stock and is now back for another shipment. He will, inside of the next month, ship from here between three and five cars of horses, which he will collect in the John Day country.

The horses which he shipped before were all large, strong animals, especially adapted to the heavy work of opening land for farming, and for these he found a ready sale. He will attempt to make the next shipment conform with the first.

Mr. Officer was greatly pleased with the country in which he was, and while there took up a homestead, which he will improve and prove up on. The land is very fertile and will make fine wheat farms, and the immigration is flocking in all winter and will be heavier in the spring.

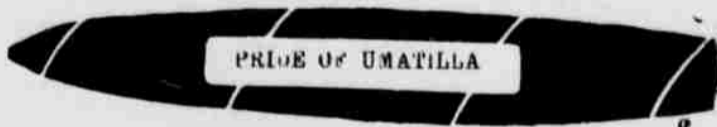
