ANNUAL TOURNAMENT
 JANUARY 21-23 INCLUSIVE

Twenty-Three Regular Events. Backed by Four Hundred Fifty Dollars Added Money—Interstate Rules to Govern All the Conditions of the Contest—Tents and Refreshments on the Grounds.

The program for the annual tournament of the Pendleton Sportsman's association is in the hands of the printers and shows that a very interesting time will be held in this city from the 21st to the 23d of January, inclusive.

There has been \$450 of added money provided, which will make some of the best purses ever offered in this part of the state. There is a better list of events and better purses than was given by the Seattle club when it gave its shoot some time ago.

The grounds will be open for practice on the 21st and on the following day the tournament will begin. The shooting will commence at 9 o'clock and there will be two days of it. In all, there will be 23 regular events, and one consolation event.

The shooting will be at known targets with unknown angles, the interstate rules will govern the tournament, and there will be 420 targets. Refreshments will be served on the grounds and no one is barred from the shooting.

Guns and ammunition sent to the city in advance will be taken care of by H. J. Stillman if they are sent in his care and the charges prepaid.

The association will give a medal for the best general average of the two days' shooting.

Tents will be provided and everything will be done to ensure the comfort and convenience of the sportsmen in attendance, and a good time is assured to all.

KANSAS POTATO LOSS.

Flood Caused \$2,006,250 Damage to Growers.

Topeka, Kan., Dec. 23.—According to the statements returned to the state board of agriculture by the county assessors, the amount of land in the Kaw river valley planted to Irish potatoes this year was 14,255 acres. It is estimated that the crop on 13,375 acres was destroyed by the June floods and was not replanted.

On the basis of 200 bushels of potatoes to the acre, the loss in bushels to the potato growers of the valley for the year was 4,012,500. At 50 cents a bushel, the smallest price received by the growers this year for their potatoes, the amount of money lost by reason of the flood was \$2,006,250. This loss was the greatest to any class of producers as a result of the June flood.

For a mile on each side of the river between this place and Kansas City the valley is almost entirely given over to the potato growing. From here west many potatoes are raised, but the industry does not thrive there as it does farther east. It is estimated that 90 per cent of all the potatoes planted in the valley were destroyed.

Kansas draws her potato supply from Colorado, Idaho and Oregon, and the shipments this year must necessarily be heavier than usual on account of this shortage.
